However, GOEA will hold back 2% on Supplemental Senior Centers until the end of the year to see if it will be needed. Mrs. Ryder also announced that EPS will return to GOEA on June 19, 2017. She explained that there will be 39 employees back but no funds for office space for the satellite offices. They are working to have those offices moved soon. Mr. Paul Colomb has retired and Amanda Smith from DOA will be his replacement for GOEA.

### **NEW BUSINESS**

- Becky Bergeron president for Louisiana Council on Aging Director's Association (LACODA), announced that they have a training on July 25-26 in Lafayette and GOEA and also EPS will train and go over policies and procedures they will be working on and watching budget information. At the luncheon held in May, Ms. Bergeron nominated Frances Thompson as legislator of the year.
