#### **OLD BUSINESS**

#### CEO REPORT

Susan T. West, CEO of OGB, gave a report to the board on the recent meeting with the House Appropriations Committee, member feedback on proposed plan changes, current trends in claims costs, and the fund balance. [Ms. West's written report is attached. – if that is correct]

#### ACTUARIAL REPORT

Mr. Thomas Tomczyk, with Buck Consultant reported the actual fiscal year 2014 there was a deficit of about \$194 million taking the fund balance down to \$207 million. The projection for fiscal year 2015 reflects changes that went into effect August 1, 2014 in the anticipated plan changes effective January 1, 2015.

#### OTHER BUSINESS

Mr. Krefft moved to postpone implementation of the proposed plan changes from January 1, 2015 until July 1, 2015. The motion was seconded by Ms. Lee.

Mr. Krefft moved to amend the motion to substitute April 1 for July 1. The amendment passed.

The motion, as amended, failed.

Mr. Smith moved that the board resolve to advise OGB to adhere to the Administrative Procedures Act in implementing the proposed plan changes. The motion was seconded by Mr. Krefft.

The motion passed.
