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Chairman Krake called to order Hearing #2020-012, LaRocca's Auto Sales, Inc. who has been engaging in the business of making consumer loans and/or origination of consumer credit sales subject to the Louisiana Motor Vehicle Sales Finance Act, LSA-R.S. 6:969.1, *et seq.*, without a license issued by the Commission. Representing LaRocca's Auto Sales, Inc. was: Joe LaRocca, Owner and Robert Harvey, Esq. A court reporter was brought into record the transcript of the hearing, which will be made a permanent part of the Commission's files. After a lengthy discussion, at the request of counsel of both parties, the Chairman announced the hearing would be continued to the next available date.

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The Executive Director advised the Commission Members a pre-hearing had been held on January 11, 2021, via ZOOM video, pursuant to LSA-R.S. 49:961C, regarding Hearing #2020-025, Supreme Autos, L.L.C. DBA Supreme Autos, 2604 Ambassador Caffery Parkway, Lafayette, LA 70506, for alleged violations of Louisiana Administrative Code Title 6. Part VII. Chapter 10-B Louisiana Motor Vehicle Sales Finance Act §969.35.A.(1) Authority to make consumer loans; assignees; authority to issue debt waiver or debt forgiveness agreements and Louisiana Administrative Code Title 46. Part V. Subpart 3. Chapter 73. Licensing §7301.A.(1) a. & b. License Requirement and Exception. In attendance representing Supreme Autos, L.L.C. DBA Supreme Autos was Liza Guidry, Owner; and representing the Commission were: Chairman Allen Krake; Counselor Gregory F. Reggie; Scott Landreneau, Commission Investigator Supervisor; Kevin Broussard, Commission Investigator; Stacey Broussard, Administrative Supervisor; Tim Knotts, Assistant; Ingya Cattle, Assistant Executive Director; and the Executive Director. The Executive Director advised the Commission Members the following Consent Judgment had been recommended by Chairman Krake and accepted by the representative of Supreme Autos, L.L.C. DBA Supreme Autos, if accepted and ratified by the Commission. Commissioner Marcotte made a motion to accept and ratify the Consent Judgment in this matter. Commissioner LeBlanc seconded this motion and it was unanimously approved.

**Alleged violations of Louisiana Administrative Code Title 6. Part VII. Chapter 10-B Louisiana Motor Vehicle Sales Finance Act §969.35.A.(1) Authority to make consumer loans; assignees; authority to issue debt waiver or debt forgiveness agreements and Louisiana Administrative Code Title 46. Part V. Subpart 3. Chapter 73. Licensing §7301.A.(1) a. & b. License Requirement and Exception**

**CONSENT JUDGMENT**

After considering the entire record in this matter and the interest of the parties in amicably resolving it, the parties have consented to a judgment in favor of the Louisiana Motor Vehicle Commission based upon alleged violations by Supreme Autos, L.L.C. DBA Supreme Autos of Louisiana Administrative Code Title 6. Part VII. Chapter 10-B Louisiana Motor Vehicle Sales Finance Act §969.35.A.(1) Authority to make consumer loans; assignees; authority to issue debt waiver or debt forgiveness agreements and Louisiana Administrative Code Title 46. Part V. Subpart 3. Chapter 73. Licensing §7301.A.(1) a. & b. License Requirement and Exception. Therefore, based on the parties' mutual consent:

**IT IS HEREBY AGREED** by and between Supreme Autos, L.L.C. DBA Supreme Autos and the Louisiana Motor Vehicle Commission that respondent waives:

- A. Any further procedural rights or remedies afforded under the law;
- B. The requirement that the Commission's judgment recites statement of a findings of fact and conclusions of law; and



C. All rights to seek judicial review or otherwise to challenge or contest the validity of the judgment entered pursuant to this agreement.

**IT IS HEREBY FURTHER AGREED** the Notice of Hearing may be used in construing the terms of the order. No agreement, understanding, representation or interpretation not contained in the order or the agreement may be used to vary or contradict the terms of the order.

**IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED** that Supreme Autos, L.L.C. DBA Supreme Autos in complete satisfaction of all above-referenced violations, pay a fine to the Louisiana Motor Vehicle Commission in the amount of TWENTY-FIVE HUNDRED (\$2,500.00) DOLLARS. The Commission agrees, as part of this settlement, that the consent judgment is prospective so any other alleged violation by Supreme Autos, L.L.C. DBA Supreme Autos of the same provision that pre-dates this consent judgment will not be pursued as a violation.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED** that TWENTY-FIVE HUNDRED (\$2,500.00) DOLLARS of this fine be suspended conditioned upon Supreme Autos, L.L.C. DBA Supreme Autos removing the credit application on its website before January 31, 2021.

**IT IS AGREED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED** that Supreme Autos, L.L.C. DBA Supreme Autos pay the cost of the pre-hearing conference to the Louisiana Motor Vehicle Commission in the amount of FOUR HUNDRED (\$400.00) DOLLARS.

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
The Executive Director reported on routine matters being handled by the staff and not requiring action by the Commission at this time.
