MEETING MINUTES

A public meeting of the Interim Emergency Board was held in Senate Committee Room E on September 13, 2019, at 9:00 a.m.

ITEM NO. 1

Sen. John Alario, board chair, called the meeting to order at 9:01 a.m., and asked that the secretary call the roll.

ITEM NO. 2

Sen. Alario requested a motion for approval of the minutes of the June 20, 2019, meeting as presented to the board. Commissioner Dardenne moved to approve the minutes as submitted. The motion passed without objection.

ITEM NO. 3

Sen. Alario asked Mr. Mark Moses, Assistant Commissioner – Facility Planning and Control, to present the information regarding item no. 3. Mr. Moses explained that the application being considered is a request to change the entity and the scope of a project in the current capital outlay bill. East Baton Rouge Parish is going to be the recipient of some federal funds for a drainage project within the parish. In order to secure the funds, they have to be authorized to receive the dollars and show that they have matching dollars. The federal funds are in the amount of \$191,750,000, which would

require a match of \$63,250,000. The total project is \$255,000,000. Currently in Act 20 of 2019 is an appropriation for the City of Central in East Baton Rouge Parish specifically for drainage within the city. Since there is not an appropriation for drainage projects in East Baton Rouge Parish, in order to authorize the dollars, the parties involved are requesting that the entity be changed from the City of Central to East Baton Rouge Parish. He added that they are also asking that the scope be changed to include drainage projects throughout East Baton Rouge Parish. There are five major drainage canals associated with the project. So they will modify the scope of the Central project to include these five major waterways. The scope of the work for Central will not be changed; it will remain as part of the scope for the project.

President Alario stated it appears that the purpose of the changes is to expand the scope of the work to include the entire parish and give more bang for the buck. He asked Senator Bodi White, who represents the City of Central, to comment on the purpose of the requested changes.

Senator White said he had worked with the Governor's attorney and with Mr. Moses on the project and was able to get all parties involved together to explain why the changes were being requested. As mentioned, the City of Central already had a drainage project in the capital outlay bill and by changing the entity and expanding the scope, it would allow for improvements to five major drainage canals, two of which are in the City of Central and three others in the rest of the parish. It will total about \$260 million plus some state dollars for the match, but East Baton Rouge Parish has committed \$8 million toward the match and the City of Central has committed \$4 million plus their capital outlay money. So everyone is contributing to the project, which will benefit the entire parish. He said they were 50-year-old projects that were never funded. He said he hoped IEB would give a favorable response to the request, which will help all parts of the parish that were devastated in the floods of 2016.

President Alario thanked Senator White, Commissioner Dardenne, and Mr. Moses for the work they had put into this project. He added that it was a good demonstration of government entities working together for the common good of the entire area, and it is much appreciated.

Representative Henry moved to approve the request, which was passed without objection.

ITEM NO. 4

Sen. Alario asked Ms. Lapeze to explain item no. 4. Ms. Lapeze said the State Treasurer's Office had reviewed the application of First National Bank of Arcadia, Louisiana, which had applied for designation as a state depository/fiscal agent for the period July 1, 2019, through June 30, 2023. This bank been a state fiscal agent bank but did not get its application submitted in time to be considered with the other applications brought before IEB in June. The Treasurer's Office ran their metrics and

determined them to be satisfactory, and she stated the bank has been doing a good job as a fiscal agent for the state. Thus, she recommended approval of their application.

Mr. Burris moved for approval; the motion passed without objection.

Commissioner Dardenne motioned to adjourn; the motion passed without objection. The meeting was adjourned at 9:08 a.m.
