MINUTES

CALL TO ORDER

Chief Anderson made a call for public comment, and none was heard.

CONSIDERATION OF MINUTES

Mayor Butler made a motion to approve the minutes of the 07/16/2025 meeting. After some discussion, Chief Craft seconded the motion and the motion passed.

Chief Ingersoll requested to attend the 2026 LEEMI New Chiefs School due to his absence from the 2025 LEEMI New Chiefs School. Chief Martin made a motion to approve the request. After some discussion, Mayor Butler seconded the motion and the motion passed.

OTHER BUSINESS

Chief Josh Ross (Arnaudville Police Dept.) presented completed training during the calendar year of 2024, and requested the training hours be approved as LEEMI Continuing Education Hours. Chief Craft made a motion to approve 6 hours of the submitted training, which is the maximum allowed training hours outside of LA Association of Chiefs of Police (LACP) Conference training hours. After some discussion, Chief Martin seconded the motion and the motion passed.

Chief Anderson announced he will be working with the LACP staff to update the form for submission of LEEMI Continuing Education hours outside of the LACP Conference training hours. Chief Anderson also announced he will be working with the LACP staff to add a page on the LACP website to thoroughly explain the LEEMI requirements, including what categories/type of training is allowed. No board action required.

Chief Anderson made a call for other business, and none was heard.
