The meeting of the Louisiana State Racing Commission was called to order by the Chairman on Monday, August 30, 2010 at 9:10 AM in the Queen Anne Ballroom of the Monteleone Hotel, 214 Royal Street, New Orleans, Louisiana. Roll call was taken; a quorum was present.

Mr. Meaux asks the commissioners for approval of the meeting minutes from the previous meeting; Mr. Roberts motions to approve; Mr. Covington seconds; motion carries.

I. ASSOCIATION REQUESTS

A. BOYD RACING, LLC d/b/a DELTA DOWNS RACETRACK, CASINO & HOTEL

1. PROGRESS REPORT, by Mr. Chris Warren. Mr. Warren informs a Louisiana Bred horse had the fastest qualifying time for the All-American Futurity in Ruidoso, New Mexico. He reports Delta Downs completed a successful 52-day quarter horse meet on July 10, 2010, even though the live handle was down 8% and the bet-in handle was off 15%. Mr. Warren states the 88-day thoroughbred meet begins on October 27, 2010. He informs the jackpot race was moved from the first Friday in December to November 20th to give the race more exposure. The jackpot purse is going to be \$1 million dollars and the total purses will be approximately \$2.4 million dollars. Mr. Warren informs the post time will change to 1:00PM for day racing and the jackpot race should go off around 4:00PM. He states more simulcast outlets will carry the event and it will be a major event due to the daytime change. Mr. Warren informs there has been \$187,000 of work completed on the racetrack. He informs the cushion was peeled back and the base was inspected. He informs the surface is looking good. The backside had work on some

of the concrete ditches and five new barns are finished. He states work has been done in the shed rows with adding new sand and clay in the stalls. The tack and feed rooms are being cleaned and should be spotless when the horses arrive. Mr. Warren states Dr. Peterson has been hired as a consultant. Mr. Warren briefly mentions the work done in the OTB area that was discussed at a prior meeting. Mr. Bourgeois asks Mr. Warren the date for letting the thoroughbred horses on the grounds. Mr. Warren replies an exact date will be provided today. Mr. Bourgeois asks Mr. Warren for the reason Delta Downs reduced the number of their quarter horse days to 46. Mr. Warren states it was a management decision to cut back to 46 quarter horse days with 10 races per day.

B. EVANGELINE DOWNS RACETRACK & CASINO

1. PROGRESS REPORT, by Mr. Coleman Lloyd. Mr. Lloyd reports Evangeline Downs has 4 days left in its thoroughbred meet. He informs, so far, the meet has been successful, however the track handle is down 11% overall and down 2% in everyday wagering. He mentions the quarter horse condition book is out and is ready for commission approval. Mr. Romero asks Mr. Lloyd about horse breakdowns at Evangeline Downs. Mr. Lloyd states there have been no complaints from the jockeys and consultant Mr. George McDermott concluded the track is fine. Mr. Lloyd states if you compare breakdowns with other tracks, the only conclusion is Evangeline Downs runs more races and cheaper horses that are susceptible to breakdowns. Mr. Lloyd states he has received no complaints from the horsemen's committee. He informs Evangeline Downs' times have been consistent. Ms. Wagner asks Mr. Lloyd if the figures for breakdowns are the same from the previous year. Mr. Lloyd responds that Dr. Hickman would be better qualified to answer. Dr. Hickman states, the overall average is the same at 2.87 per thousand. Mr. Lloyd reiterates his explanation for the breakdowns, based on the quality of horses being run. Mr. Krantz asks Mr. Lloyd if they had any outside analysis on the breakdown issue. Mr. Lloyd states Dr. Peterson is scheduled to make an analysis in the near future. He informs local people have analyzed the track and state the consistency is fine. Mr. Krantz asks Mr. Lloyd if Dr. Peterson will analyze both surfaces. Mr. Lloyd responds, yes. Mr. Romero asks Mr. Lloyd if it will be done before the quarter horse meet. Mr. Lloyd responds that an exact date is not set due to Dr. Peterson's work schedule. Mr. Covington states that Evangeline Downs has been very cooperative with the commission. Mr. Krantz offers a motion to mandate that Evangeline Downs hire Dr. Peterson to assess both racing surfaces, at Evangeline Downs' expense and the track be mandated to commit to his recommendations and report Dr. Peterson's findings to the commission; Mr. Covington seconds; motion carries.

Ms. Chatelain informs Attorney David Waguespack submitted Fair Grounds' OTB application to the Racing Commission office and has supplied the Commission with all of the documents necessary to verify that they are in proper posture for approval.

Mr. Alfortish informs he will meet with his Board at their next meeting to discuss and resolve this issue.

Ms. Wagner asks Mr. Bryant if the stalls will be full for the upcoming quarter horse meet and the costs associated for opening up early. Mr. Bryant informs the stalls are anticipated to reach capacity and the cost will run between \$7,000 & \$10,000 per day. He

informs, by opening on September 15th, the cost is estimated to be \$200,000.

1. PROGRESS REPORT, by Mr. Trent McIntosh. Mr. McIntosh introduces Mr. Mike Rich, the new general manager of Louisiana Downs. Mr. Rich addresses the Commission and informs of his background with Harrah's. II. COMMITTEE REPORTS

A. MEDICATION COMMITTEE, by Committee Chairman Payton R. Covington

Mr. Covington reports the Medication Committee met with, HBPA members, private veterinarians, regulating veterinarians and racetrack personnel on August 13, 2010. He states the meeting mainly dealt with horse scratches. As a result of the meeting, the Medication Committee proposes: 1.) If a horse is pre-race scratched and the trainer has objections, a second regulatory veterinarian may be called. 2.) The trainer must be notified in writing if the horse is put on the vet's list. 3.) Horses post-race being on the vet's list should be given a second examination, except for obvious infirmities, if asked by the trainer. Mr. Covington motions to affirm the Medication Committee's report; Mr. Krantz seconds; report affirmed.

B. RULES COMMITTEE, by Committee Chairman Keith W. Babb

Mr. Babb provides a review of the rules (LAC 35: I.1304 Mandatory Health Screening, LAC 35: I.1727 Drugs Which Affects Performance; Guarding Horse and LAC 35: I.1743 Possession of Drugs, Syringes or Needles) which are scheduled for approval later in the meeting.

- C. LEGAL COMMITTEE, by Committee Chairman Bob F. Wright
 - Mr. Wright states that he has no report.
- D. RACETRACK/HBPA LIAISON COMMITTEE, by Committee Chairman Ray A. Tromba Mr. Tromba is not present. No report.
- E. SECURITY COMMITTEE, by Committee Chairman Kenneth "Kenu" Romero Mr. Romero states that he has no report.
- F. COMPLIANCE COMMITTEE, by Committee Chairman Anthony Bourgeois Mr. Bourgeois states that he has no report.

III. RULES

A. Emergency/Notice of Intent:

1. LAC 35: I.1304 Mandatory Health Screening

Mr. Alfortish states Piroplasmosis is passed by needles and/or ticks. Mr. Alfortish also states his investigation shows that tracks only, not governmental agencies pass this rule. He informs \$80 per certificate will be a burden for the horsemen. He states that it has not been a prevalent problem in Louisiana. He further states that it is not a rule in other states and that out-of-state tracks have implemented this as an in-house rule. He states the rule should not be adopted. Mr. Babb states that the Commission should not wait until there is a problem. Mr. Wright asks Mr. Alfortish if HBPA representatives were at the August 13, 2010 committee meeting. Mr. Alfortish responds, yes. Mr. Meaux states the Department of Agriculture asked the LRC to adopt this rule. Ms. Chatelain informs there have been horses at Louisiana Downs that were carriers. Mr. Early informs that he has not heard or received anything from the Livestock Sanitary Board on Piroplasmosis. Mr. Early states that he doesn't understand the emergency aspect of this rule. Mr. Meaux informs adjoining states all have Piroplasmosis rules. Mr. Wright asks Mr. Alfortish if the problem is with the cost of the test. Mr. Alfortish answers it is the cost and the test has no validity. Dr. Hickman explains the severity of this disease and the need for an emergency rule. Mr. Gardiner explains the quarantine process and informs the disease affects the horse's performance and the betting public will be betting on a sick horse.

Mr. Wright motions to approve the rule as a notice of intent and as an emergency; Ms. Wagner seconds; Poll vote: 6-yes, 2-no; motion carries. An effective date was not determined at this time.

Coleman Lloyd confirms no horses can enter the grounds without a negative test.

Not present; Mr. Covington motions to uphold the stewards' ruling; suspend 6 months from 7/14/10 through 1/14/11 plus an additional 5-year suspension from 1/15/11 through 1/14/16. Denied access to all race tracks, off-track wagering facilities and recognized training tracks under the jurisdiction of the Louisiana State Racing Commission; Mr. Krantz seconds; motion carries.

Appeal/Referred (LA. REV. STAT. 4:154, 4:172)

Frederick D. Shay, Owner/Trainer. Ruling#DD18139 of 7/15/10 – Ractopamine (ARCI Category II). Mr. Covington motions to uphold the stewards' ruling; suspension reduced to 60 days from 8/30/10 through 10/28/10; fined \$1,500. Denied access to all race tracks, off-track wagering facilities and recognized training tracks under the jurisdiction of the Louisiana State Racing Commission; Mr. Wright seconds; motion carries.

VI. OTHER

Mr. Meaux, Ms. Chatelain, Mr. Wright, Mr. Covington, Mr. Gardiner, Mr. Krantz and Dr. Barker discuss the proper category and class of the drug Ractopamine. Dr. Barker offers his personal and professional opinion, stating ARCI made an error in their categorization of Ractopamine. He recommends classifying Ractopamine as a Category 2 instead of a Category 3 since there is no therapeutic value in a horse and high potential for abuse. Ms. Chatelain recommends any future Ractopamine positives be called a Category 3 because that is what RCI has classified the drug and that Dr. Barker can submit an addendum, stating his expert opinion. Mr. Wright motions for the Medication Committee to evaluate the matter and report back to the Commission with a recommendation; Mr. Krantz seconds; motion carries.

VII. ADJOURNMENT

Mr. Meaux adjourns the meeting.
