CALL TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order by Dr. Ansel Rankins, Sr. at 9:33 a.m.

PUBLIC COMMENTS

There were no public comments.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Motion: Mr. Kimbrough made a motion to approve the minutes from the March 20, 2024, meeting. The motion was seconded by Mr. Horton and passed unanimously.

ADJUDICATORY HEARINGS

Hearing Officer Tanika Starks conducted the hearing. LDAF Attorney Jade Saunders presented the following cases:

STIPULATED CASES

Case No. 24-SPCC-2541 Jeremy Calais Don's Exterminating Co. PO Box 90188 Lafayette, LA 70509

The Department charged Jeremy Calais with :

One (1) violation of La. R.S. 3:3371(A)(14); specifically, LAC 7:XXV.141(E)(4) One (1) violation of La. R.S. 3:3371(A)(3) One (1) violation of La. R.S. 3:3371(A)(6)

Mr. Calais was not present. The department and Mr. Calais entered into a stipulation in which Respondent admits to the allegations and agrees to pay the penalty of \$2000.00 within 30-days after receipt of the Commission's acceptance. The stipulation was signed by all parties.

Motion: Mr. Horton made a motion to accept the facts set forth in the stipulation and that the penalty be accepted. The motion was seconded by Mr. Kimbrough and passed unanimously.

Case No. 24-SPCC-2559 Thomas Casselberry

The Department charged Thomas Casselberry with :

One (1) violation of La. R.S. 3:3371(A)(14); specifically, LAC 7.XXV.117(K) and LAC 7.XXV.119(D) One (1) violation of La. R.S. 3:3371(A)(14); specifically, LAC 7.XXV.117(L) and LAC 7.XXV.119(E)

Mr. Casselberry was not present. The department and Mr. Castleberry entered into a stipulation in which Respondent admits to the allegations and agrees to pay the penalty of \$1200.00, with \$600.00 being suspended, within 30-days after receipt of the Commission's acceptance. The stipulation was signed by all parties.

Motion: Dr. Rankins, Sr. made a motion to accept the facts set forth in the stipulation and that the penalty be accepted. The motion was seconded by Mr. Horton and passed unanimously.

Mr. McDonald was not present. The department and Mr. McDonald entered into a stipulation in which Respondent admits to the allegations and agrees to pay the penalty of \$500.00, with \$250.00 being suspended, within 30-days after receipt of the Commission's acceptance. The stipulation was signed by all parties.

Motion: Mr. Kimbrough made a motion to accept the facts set forth in the stipulation and that the penalty be accepted. The motion was seconded by Mr. Horton and passed unanimously.

R.S. 3:3371(A)(7); specifically, LAC 7:XXV.117(K) Fourteen (14) violations of La. R.S. 3:3371(A)(14); specifically, LAC 7:XXV.117(L)

Mr. Williams was not present but was represented by legal counsel, Shane Sandefer. Mr. Sandefer requested a continuance, which was granted until the next commission meeting.

The Department charged Joseph Cohn with:

One (1) violation of La. R.S. 3:3371(A)(14) specifically, LAC 7:XXV.117(H)(I) One (1) violation of La. R.S. 3:3371(A)(14); specifically, LAC 7:XXV.101(B) One (1) violation of La. R.S. 3:3371(A)(14); specifically, LAC 7:XXV.141(E)(1) One (1) violation of La. R.S. 3:3371(A)(14); specifically, LAC 7:XXV.101(A)(6)

Mr. Cohn was present and was represented by legal counsel, David Cohn.

LDAF Exhibit 1, the charge letter, was offered, filed and introduced into evidence. LDAF Exhibit 2 in globo, the inspection reports and supporting documentation were offered, filed, and introduced into evidence.

Meredith Williams-Mautemps, LDAF AES 2; Amy Hernandez, LDAF Pesticide Lab Supervisor and Kelly Moore, LDAF Director of Structural Pest Control; were called as witnesses on behalf of the department.

Motion: Mr. Kimbrough made a motion to deny dismissal of the charges in the fourth violation. . The motion was seconded by Mr. Horton and passed unanimously.

Blaine Poche, and Claire Kelly, both employees of Arrow Pest Control were called as witnesses on behalf of Mr. Cohn.

Motion: Mr. Kimbrough made a motion to dismiss the charges of the second violation, one (1) violation of La. R.S. 3:3371(A)(14); specifically, LAC 7:XXV.101(B). The motion was seconded by Dr. Rankins, Sr. and passed unanimously.

Motion: Mr. Kimbrough made a motion to find Joseph Cohn in violation of the first violation, one (1) violation of La. R.S. 3:3371(A)(14) specifically, LAC 7:XXV.117(H)(I), and to assess a penalty of \$200. The motion was seconded by Dr. Rankins, Sr. and passed unanimously.

Motion: Mr. Kimbrough made a motion to find Joseph Cohn in violation of the third violation presented, one (1) violation of La. R.S. 3:3371(A)(14); specifically, LAC 7:XXV.141(E)(1) and to assess a penalty of \$300. The motion was seconded by Mr. Horton and passed unanimously.

Motion: Dr. Rankins, Sr. made a motion to find Joseph Cohn in violation of the fourth violation charges presented, one (1) violation of La. R.S. 3:3371(A)(14); specifically, LAC 7:XXV.101(A)(6) and to assess a penalty of \$200. The motion was seconded by Mr. Horton and passed unanimously.

d. Approval of Rules – ADA

Ms. Bethany Gonzales, LDAF Attorney, presented the board with proposed rules to accommodate persons with disabilities participation in open meetings as required by Act 393 of the 2023 legislative session.

Motion: Mr. Kimbrough moved to approve the proposed rules and allow the department to promulgate the rules on the commission's behalf. Mr. Horton second the motion and it passed unanimously.

R.S. 3:3371(A)(14); specifically, LAC 7:XXV.119(A)(4) One (1) violation of La. R.S. 3:3371(A)(14); specifically, LAC 7:XXV.117(H)(1) One (1) violation of La. R.S. 3:3371(A)(14); specifically, LAC 7:XXV.117(H)(2)

Mr. Cohn was present and represented by legal counsel, David Cohn. David Cohn requested that the case be continued.

Ms. Moore; Lyndon Leonards, LDAF Director of Pesticides and Environmental Programs; and Alvin Anding, Agriculture Environmental Specialist Manager were called as witnesses on behalf of the department.

Mr. Cohn offered, filed an introduced, the Arrow Pest Control record for the address in question, it was admitted into evidence as Jacob 1.

Ms. Jackson made a recommendation of fines for the following violations: Violation 3, a fine of \$500.00; Violation 4, a fine of \$200.00; and Violation 5, a fine - \$500.00.

Motion: Mr. Kimbrough made a motion to find Mr. Jacob Cohn in violation of the Violation 3 charge. The motion was seconded by Dr. Ashbrook and passed unanimously.

Motion: Mr. Kimbrough made a motion to find Mr. Jacob Cohn -in violation of Violation 3 charges and to assess a penalty of \$200. The motion was seconded by Mr. Horton and passed unanimously.

Motion: Mr. Kimbrough made a motion to dismiss Violation 4 charges. The motion was seconded by Mr. Horton and failed to pass with a vote of 2 yes -2 no.

Substitution Motion: Mr. Horton made a motion to find Mr. Cohn in violation of the violation 4 charges. The motion was seconded by Dr. Rankins Sr. and passed with a vote of 3 yes - 1 no

Motion: Dr. Rankins, Sr., made a motion to find Mr. Cohn to assess a penalty of \$200 for the violation of Violation 4. The motion was seconded by Mr. Horton and passed with a vote of 3 yes -1 no.

Motion: Dr. Rankins, Sr. made a motion to find Mr. Cohn in violation of Violation 5 charge. The motion was seconded by Mr. Kimbrough and passed unanimously.

Motion: Mr. Kimbrough made a motion to find Mr. Cohn in violation of Violation 5 charges and to assess a penalty of \$500.00. The motion was seconded by Dr. Rankins and passed unanimously.

David Cohn requested to have violation 2 dismissed.

Motion: Mr. Kimbrough made a motion to dismiss violation 2 of the charges presented. The motion was not seconded and failed to pass.

Motion: Dr. Rankins Sr. made a motion to find Mr. Cohn in violation of violation 2 charges. The motion was seconded by Mr. Horton and passed.

Jacob Cohn, Arrow Pest Control and Steven Richardson, Arrow Pest Control were called as witnesses on witnesses on behalf of the respondent.

Motion: Dr. Rankins, Sr., made a motion to find Mr. Cohn guilty of Violation 1 charges without penalty. The motion was seconded by Mr. Horton and passed unanimously.

Motion: Dr. Rankins, Sr., made a motion to suspend any penalty. The motion was seconded by Mr. Horton and passed unanimously.
