CALL TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order by Mr. Bass at 9:14 a.m.

ROLL CALL

Other present: Harry Schexnayder, LDAF, Kevin Wofford, LDAF, Tyrone Dudley, LDAF, Chris Mora, LDAF Counsel, Lindsey Hunter, Hearing Officer, Mary Anderson, LDAF and Lisa Hall, LDAF.

AMENDMENTS TO THE AGENDA

Mr. Schexnayder asked the commission to amend the agenda to add Mr. Jay Coleman to discuss fumigation at the end of New Business.

Motion: Mr. Kunst made a motion to add Mr. Coleman to the New Business. This motion was seconded by Dr. Schowalter and passed unanimously.

Mr. Schexnayder asked the commission to amend the agenda to include Nicky Hebert from DOW to present minor changes to the Recruit IV AG label. Mr. Kunst said that any changes to a termiticide label should come before the commission as done in the past.

Motion: Mr. Kunst made a motion to move the discussion of this label change to New Business and that LDAF would supply a hard copy for review at this meeting. This motion was seconded by Mr. Foster and passed unanimously.

Motion: Mr. Parker made a motion to approve the minutes. This motion was seconded by Dr. Schowalter and passed unanimously.

NEW BUSINESS

LPMA, Jeff Porter

Mr. Porter reported that another successful Summer Institute is in progress. He noted that the newly hired LDAF inspectors were attending the Summer Institute and thanked the industry for helping fund their fees.

Research Committee

Mr. Schexnayder reported that the committee had met in July and Dr. Henderson gave an update on his research. Mr. Schexnayder reported that the Research Committee recommended that commission to continue funding this research.

Motion: Mr. Foster made a motion to continue funding the research. This motion was seconded by Dr. Schowalter and passed unanimously.

Rules Committee

Mr. Schexnayder reported on the Rules Committee meeting. After discussion, the following motions were made by the commission:

Motion: Mr. Kunst made a motion to approve the proposed changes to §117. This motion was seconded by Mr. Foster and passed unanimously.

Motion: Mr. Kunst made a motion to approve the proposed changes to §141, B 4 Minimum Specifications, rodding. This motion was seconded by Mr. Foster and passed unanimously.

Motion: Mr. Parker made a motion to change each area where rodding specifications are found in the rules, to include the proposed changes to §141, B 4, as approved in the previous motion. This motion was seconded by Mr. Foster and passed unanimously.

Mr. Bass called for a recess.

Mr. Bass called the meeting back to order at 10:00 am. All commission members were present.

Motion: Mr. Kunst made a motion to send the Hollow Block /Pier proposed changes to the LPMA Review Committee for comments. This motion was seconded by Mr. Foster and passed unanimously.

Motion: Mr. Kunst made a motion to approve the proposed changes to 10 D – 1C slab to address rodding. This motion was seconded by Mr. Foster and passed unanimously.

Motion: Mr. Kunst made a motion to approve the proposed changes to E, preconstruction of slabs. This motion was seconded by Mr. Foster and passed unanimously.

Motion: Mr. Foster made a motion to approve the proposed changes to D, Bait Station/Monitoring. This motion was seconded by Mr. Kunst and passed unanimously.

Motion: Mr. Foster made a motion to remove the Pilot Program from the rules.

Amended Motion: Mr. Foster made a motion to approve to remove the Pilot Program from the Rules with the exception of those products currently in the Pilot Program. This amended motion was seconded by Mr. Kunst and passed unanimously.

Public Hearing

Mr. Schexnayder reported that a Public Hearing was held, and public comments were heard on the intent. The Intent was incorrectly published and will have to be published again and another public hearing held.

Mr. Kunst requested that all information on all changes to definition of Hydraulics be sent to the commission prior to submission.

Term Limits

Mr. Kunst requested information on Term Limits of the commission members. Mr. Mora gave to the commission the part of RS42:3.2 applicable to the term limits.

Jay Coleman – Fumigation

Mr. Coleman gave an overview of fumigation and the different types of information requested when getting approved to take testing. Mr. Kunst requested that this issue be reviewed by the rules committee and to invite Mr. Coleman to the next rules committee meeting.

Motion: Mr. Foster made a motion to review this issue to the rules committee. This motion was seconded by Dr. Schowalter and passed unanimously.

Motion: Mr. Kunst made a motion to amend the agenda to include a discussion on requirements for liquid termiticide with spot treatment. This motion was seconded by Mr. Foster and passed unanimously.

After discussion by the commission members a motion was made.

Motion: Mr. Kunst made a motion to recommend to the rules committee this issue. This motion was seconded by Mr. Foster and passed unanimously.

Recruit IV AG – DOW AgroSciences, Nicky Hebert

Mr. Hebert presented the label changes.

Motion: Mr. Kunst made a motion to approve the label changes. This motion was seconded by Mr. Foster and passed unanimously.

Mr. Bass turned the meeting over to Ms. Hunter.

Mr. Schexnayder read the stipulations.

Mr. Michael Cohn, Case No. 1738 – Mr. Cohn stipulated to 3 violations and a fine of \$500.00 per violation for a total payable fine of \$1500. The department agreed to dismiss the fourth violation.

Motion: Mr. Kunst made a motion to accept the stipulation as read. This motion was seconded by Dr. Schowalter and passed unanimously.

Patrick Salvant, Case No. 1787 – Mr. Salvant stipulated to one violation for a total payable fine of \$500.00.

Motion: Mr. Foster made a motion to accept the stipulation as read. This motion was seconded by Dr. Schowalter and passed unanimously.

Ms. Hunter turned the meeting back over to Mr. Bass.
