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3	MR. LAYRISSON:
4	This is Bry Layrisson. I would like to call this meeting
5	to order on June 16, 2011, for the Supplemental Pay Board.

9	Danielle Leboeuf, Board member.

11	Paul Schexnayder, Attorney.
12	MS. ROBERTS:
13	Susan Roberts, staff.
14	MS. KIKER:
15	Lee Ann Kiker, staff.
16	APPROVAL OF MINUTES OF FEBRUARY 16, 2011 MEETING
17	MR. LAYRISSON:
18	The first item on the agenda is approval of the minutes.
19	I would like to do a motion that we put this off until the
20	next meeting.
21	MS. LEBOEUF:
22	I'll second it.
23	OLD BUSINESS
24	Gretna Police Department - Christopher Tapie
25	MS. ROBERTS:

The first thing we have on our agenda for old business is 1 Gretna Police Department, Christopher Tapie. Paul -- I spoke 2 with Paul yesterday about this. 3 MR. LAYRISSON: 4 Still nothing? 5 6 MR. SCHEXNAYDER: Nothing from the AG's Office from our request. I think 7 8 it is going to take a little time. 9 MS. ROBERTS: 10 Any questions about that? MR. SCHEXNAYDER: 11 Wait. You did say that he is back. 12 MS. ROBERTS: 13 He is going to be on our list, because I -- he came back 14 15 from the military, and he needed like six weeks, so I have added the six weeks back in, but he has been added to the 16 17 list. I believe his effective date was like March 7th or something like that, but he will be getting supplemental pay 18 this time. 19 20 MR. SCHEXNAYDER: 21 It's a long issue. It will be back pay. 22 MS. ROBERTS: 23 It will be back pay. 24 MS. LEBOEUF:

ROBERTS: If it is approved or whatever, we would owe -- you 2 know, if they said that it goes back to, you know, count his 3 military service, then we would owe him some money, but as of 4 right now, he is going on supplemental pay. 5 6 MR. LAYRISSON: The current bill -- Senate Bill No. 141 filed in this 7 current session, is that related to this matter? 8 MS. ROBERTS: 10 I think it is. 11 (Off-the-record discussion.) 12 **NEW BUSINESS** 13 Bunkie Police Department - Wanda Lacassin MS. ROBERTS: 14 Okay. New business, the first thing on there is Bunkie 15 Police Department, Wanda Lacassin. I brought this before the 16 Board. It may not need to be brought before the Board, but 17 now I am kind of like confused with all the P.O.S.T. stuff. 18 Ms. Lacassin was the chief of police at Krotz Springs and 19 was getting supplemental pay until December 31st of this year. 20 Well, she left there. She went to Bunkie, and she was a 21 22 grandfathered person, so she had a break of service. 23 Therefore, I didn't know if I could put her back on. have a letter from P.O.S.T. that says her P.O.S.T. is still 24 She didn't lose -- you know, she is still P.O.S.T. 25 valid.

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1 because she hasn't had a break of more than five years, she is considered P.O.S.T. certified. 2 3 MR. LAYRISSON: Five years, yes. 4 5 MS. ROBERTS: They give them a new certificate, which they have 6 7 attached to it, so I am just trying to make sure what I do is 8 right. MR. LAYRISSON: 9 10 It is my opinion that she should be getting supplemental 11 pay, unless Paul tells us otherwise. 12 MR. SCHEXNAYDER: 13 You know, if you read the law strictly -- it intends to say if you were hired after January 1, 1986, you have to be 14 P.O.S.T. certified, but if they are going to come in and say 15 16 they are P.O.S.T. certified --MR. LAYRISSON: 17 18 Yes. I don't think she loses her grandfather clause, unless she sits out longer than the five-year period. 19 MS. LEBOEUF: 20 21 Right. I agree. 22 MR. SCHEXNAYDER: 23 She's still P.O.S.T. certified. MS. LEBOEUF: 24

## 7 MS. ROBERTS: And that is what they're telling us, and they sent us --2 we have a letter attached with them telling us that, so... MS. LEBOEUF: 4 5 Now, they do have her employment history wrong, on the P.O.S.T. letter --6 7 MS. ROBERTS: 8 I ao by --MS. LEBOEUF: 9 10 -- compared to what she put on her application -- I'm sorry -- on her prior service. 11 12 MS. ROBERTS: 13 Yes. I always go by what P.O.S.T. gives me, because they send -- they have to send, I think, the department --14 15 MS. LEBOEUF: 16 (Inaudible.) MS. ROBERTS: 17 18 Yes, so I usually go by what is on this letter from P.O.S.T. 19 20 MS. LEBOEUF: Do we have any -- is there any -- and just I -- because I 21 22 haven't heard it before, but is there any rule or policy or 23 statute that says, other than the five years, you know, like 24 if somebody leaves one and goes to another -- say, he wasn't a 25 chief, okay, say somebody leaves -- say, you leave Ponchatoula

1	and go to Baton Rouge, and you have a two-week break in
2	service. Your P.O.S.T. is still eligible, so it's a wash.
3	It's nothing.
4	MR. LAYRISSON:
5	The title doesn't matter. It is five years.
6	MS. LEBOEUF:
7	That's what I thought.
8	MR. LAYRISSON:
9	Whether you are the chief or the chief's bottle washer.
10	MS. LEBOEUF:
11	Right, that is what I thought. Okay.
12	MR. LAYRISSON:
13	I make a motion that we give her back pay, if she is owed
14	any, and continue paying her supplemental pay.
15	MS. LEBOEUF:
16	And I'll second that.
17	Elizabeth Police Department - Shane Ware
18	MS. ROBERTS:
19	Okay. The next thing on our agenda is Elizabeth Police
20	Department, Shane Ware. This is someone who we have questions
21	about just to make sure that, do elected chiefs of police
22	how many hours do they have to work a minimum of hours?
23	MR. SCHEXNAYDER:
24	The law is silent on that. There seems to be a provision
25	for elected marshals, that they are immediately entitled to

it, and I think the Board has taken the position that, if 1 2 elected marshals are entitled to it immediately, so should elected chiefs of police. 3 MS. ROBERTS: 4 5 Yes. MR. SCHEXNAYDER: 6 You can go with the policy of the past. 7 MR. LAYRISSON: 8 I just ask that we review his application and verify that 9 he is an elected chief and not appointed, and that he has 10 11 successful completed P.O.S.T, and if both of those have been met, then I recommend that we give him back pay effective on 12 his P.O.S.T. graduation date to current. 13 MS. LEBOEUF: 14 I'll second that. 15 Henderson Police Department - Dustin Landreneau 16 MS. ROBERTS: 17 18 The next thing we have is Henderson Police Department, Dustin Landreneau. I received something -- I received a phone 19 call in regards to this matter, and -- that he had questions 20 to the Board in regards to him receiving supplemental pay 21 maybe when he shouldn't have. Therefore, he submitted a 22 letter to us, which is attached, and a copy of his 23 application. Yes, that is what he did tell me, and I forgot 24

about that, he said he wasn't writing tickets, so they -- they

1	had to write a certain number of tickets, and if they didn't		
2	do that, then they were let go.		
3	MR. LAYRISSON:		
4	I would recommend that we consider doing an in-house		
5	audit for the Town of Henderson to have prepared to hand over		
6	to some type of law enforcement investigative unit due to the		
7	criminal allegations.		
8	MS. LEBOEUF:		
9	Okay. I'll second that.		
10	LEGAL MATTERS		
11	MS. ROBERTS:		
12	The next thing we have is legal matters. Paul, do you		
13	have anything?		
14	MR. SCHEXNAYDER:		
15	The only issue is the Christopher Tapie matter, and we		
16	still don't have anything.		
17	MS. ROBERTS:		
18	Okay.		
19	NEW APPLICATIONS SUBMITTED FOR APPROVAL		
20	MS. ROBERTS:		
21	And we have our new applications. I have the list		
22	attached for you to review. I have reviewed them.		
23	MS. LEBOEUF:

It is going to be like in August whenever I do it 5 6 again, so... MS. LEBOEUF: 7 It is not many this time at all. 8 MS. ROBERTS: 9 10 But it is not a lot. I have a couple from maybe the last meeting we had or something, so -- but I haven't submitted it 11 12 yet. 13 MS. LEBOEUF: That's good, maybe they will end up getting it. 14 MS. ROBERTS: 1.5 We are trying real hard. Lee Ann and I are both -- we 16 are making sure our meetings -- even like this meeting, we 17 18 made sure every Act that we had in the office through probably 19 yesterday is on this list. So nobody -- we pray we don't have 20 much Act 110 this time. 21 MS. LEBOEUF: 22 Yes. I don't blame you. 23 MS. ROBERTS: 24 And New Orleans is even trying to get their paperwork done. We don't have as many. I mean, we have a couple, but 25

12	year, at least we have a positive number, so everything is	
13	fine. I mean, Fire looks a little off, so they are fooling	
14	with that right now, so it is going to be okay, too.	
15	So that's really all we have.	
16	SET TIME AND DATE OF NEXT MEETING	
17	MS. ROBERTS:	
18	And then set the time and date of our next meeting. I	
19	have it tentatively scheduled for September 1st, so, I mean,	
20	that is subject to change. I know it's around Labor Day and	
21	all that, but we can I will send a message out.	
22	MR. SCHEXNAYDER:	
23	What day of the week?	
24	MS. ROBERTS:	
25	It's a Thursday. Do you want to do another day?	

1	MR. SCHEXNAYDER:
2	I was just wondering if it was the holiday.
3	MS. LEBOEUF:
4	Is it the Thursday before Labor Day?
5	MS. ROBERTS:
6	Yes, yes. So, we can do another I mean, we are still
7	kind of early, also, if you all want I will send it out
8	probably about August, and we can do another day. Thursday is
9	not - whatever day is good for you.
10	MS. LEBOEUF:
11	As long as it's not staff meeting.
12	MS. ROBERTS:
13	Do you all usually do it the first do you do it once a
14	week?
15	MS. LEBOEUF:
16	Once a month.
17	MS. ROBERTS:
18	Okay. And it could be the 1st?
19	MS. LEBOEUF:
20	I can't remember.
21	MS. ROBERTS:
22	Okay. Well, like I said, like around the first or second
23	week of August I try to start doing getting ready for it.
24	MS. LEBOEUF:
25	That's good.
