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1		CALL TO ORDER
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3	MR.	LAYRISSON:
4		I would like to call the Wednesday, November 7th
5	meet	ting to order.
6		APPROVAL OF MINUTES OF MEETINGS - 6/7/12 AND 9/13/12
7	MR.	LAYRISSON:
8		The first item on the agenda is the approval of the
9	minu	ates for the June 7, 2012, and September 13, 2012,
10	meet	ings.
11	MS.	LEBOEUF:
12		I will make a motion to approve them.
13	MR.	LAYRISSON:
14		Okay. We have a motion. Do we have a second?
15	MS.	LEBOEUF:
16		I guess I'll second it. Can I second it?
17	COURT REPORTER:	
18		You can second it.
19	MR.	LAYRISSON:
20		I'll second.
21		All in favor, "aye."
22		Aye.
23	MS.	LEBOEUF:
24		Aye.
25		Without Ternisa, it's kind of hard.

1	MR. LAYRISSON:
2	Yes.
3	OLD BUSINESS
4	Maringouin Police Department - John Simien
5	MR. LAYRISSON:
6	Okay. The next item on the agenda is old business,
7	Maringouin Police Department, John Simien. He was unable
8	to make it to the meeting due to a doctor's appointment.
9	He sent us a letter if everyone wants to take a minute to
10	review it, especially our counsel.
11	MR. SCHEXNAYDER:
12	Yes. I am familiar with this case. Susan discussed
13	it with me before she went on leave.
14	He is not P.O.S.T. certified wasn't P.O.S.T.
15	certified. She told me he shouldn't have been put on in
16	the first place.
17	MR. LAYRISSON:
18	Correct.
19	MS. LEBOEUF:
20	I mean, I wonder what he's got to say that it would
21	be very interesting.
22	MR. SCHEXNAYDER:
23	I know.
24	MR. LEBOEUF:
25	I'll make a motion to defer until Chief Simien can

1	appear before the Board.
2	MR. LAYRISSON:
3	I'll second.
4	NEW BUSINESS
5	Act 110 - Edwin Beraud and Flora Rogers
6	MR. LAYRISSON:
7	The next item on the agenda is new business, Act 110,
8	Edwin Beraud and Flora Rogers.
9	MS. RYLAND:
LO	These two are individuals that had suspensions earlier
L1	in the year, and they've been rescinded, so the money will
L2	be in back pay and added to the Act 110 list for our next
L3	submittal.
4	MR. LAYRISSON:
L5	Okay.
L6	MS. LEBOEUF:
L7	This is just an FYI, right?
L8	MS. RYLAND:
L9	Yes.
20	MS. LEBOEUF:
21	Okay. We don't have to vote on it.
22	Zachary Police Department - Tracy McNeely and Melody Hills
23	MR. LAYRISSON:
24	The next item on the agenda is the Zachary Police
25	Department, Tracy McNeely and Melody Hills.

We've previously addressed this issue with the Hammond Police Department and whether or not anyone certified with a firearm does not affect their supplemental pay, so, if we can have the office send a letter to that effect. Probably if you reference the Hammond Police Department, you can probably get what you need off of that letter. MS. LEBOEUF: Yes. MR. LAYRISSON: The next item on the agenda is Port Fourchon Harbor Police, Mr. Daniel --MR. SCHEXNAYDER: Before we do that, I --MR. LAYRISSON: I'm sorry. MR. SCHEXNAYDER: One thing I seem to remember, P.O.S.T. had talked about changing some rules because I remember when that issue did come up, but I don't know if they ever did or not. MS. LEBOEUF: I don't either. MS. RYLAND: Should I have them verify that their P.O.S.T. is still valid?

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1	MR.	LAYRISSON:
2		Yes.
3	MR.	SCHEXNAYDER:
4		That would probably be a good idea.
5	MS.	LEBOEUF:
6		Yes.
7	MR.	LAYRISSON:
8		That is the issue we've always run into. Other than
9	the	five-year window, you pretty much never lose your
10	P.O.	S.T. certification.
11	MR.	SCHEXNAYDER:
12		Right. Maybe just ask them if they changed any rules.
13	MS.	LEBOEUF:
14		Yes, because, at one time, they said they were going
15	to,	but I don't know if they did.
16		Port Fourchon Harbor Police - Daniel Dardar, Jr.
17	MIR.	LAYRISSON:
18		The next item on the agenda is Port Fourchon Harbor
19	Pol:	ice, Mr. Daniel Dardar. We also have the police chief
20	here	e to answer any questions that the Board may have.
21	MS.	LEBOEUF:
22		Katie, do you know if he was receiving supplemental
23	pay	at Maryville and/or Golden Meadow?
24	MS.	RYLAND:
2 5		I didn!t werify that but

## CHIEF CALLAIS: 1 I don't know. 2 3 MS. LEBOEUF: You don't know? Okay. I am just curious. I mean, we 4 can speak to the Sheriff's Office, but --5 Do you know what the job title is of the other people 6 at the Harbor Police that are receiving supplemental pay, 7 8 Katie, it's just a thought? I don't know. MR. LAYRISSON: 9 10 Chief, he was only required to do the refreshed? CHIEF CALLAIS: 11 12 He was only required to do the refresher, yes, sir. 13 MR. LAYRISSON: And is this correct that he left Golden Meadow in '99, 14 15 has he worked anywhere between '99 and --CHIEF CALLAIS: 16 17 Not in law enforcement. He was in security with the Lake Charles -- the casino? 18 19 MR. SCHEXNAYDER: 20 L'auberge. 21 CHIEF CALLAIS: 22 L'auberge, yes. MS. LEBEOUF: 23 I'm surprised they didn't -- that's more than five for 24 25 sure.

## MR. LAYRISSON: 1 Because I would say -- you know, initially, I would 2 3 say that he's not eligible, but P.O.S.T. -- that's on P.O.S.T. not on us. 4 MR. SCHEXNAYDER: Right. 6 7 CHIEF CALLAIS: 8 I don't know if he -- he put in his packet the letter back from P.O.S.T. saying that he only required the --9 10 MS. LEBOEUF: That would be nice to have, that he only required 11 refresher? 12 CHIEF CALLAIS: 13 -- the refresher. 14 MR. LAYRISSON: 15 16 He's got it, so... 17 MS. LEBOEUF: Here's his P.O.S.T., his prior service, 1996 --18 MR. LAYRISSON: 19 20 He's got in his letter that he was P.O.S.T. certified in '96. 21 22 MS. LEBOEUF: So then he must have been receiving it. 23 Is a compliance coordinator eligible -- I mean, I 24 25 don't --

1	MR. SCHEXNAYDER:
2	It does have in his description that he makes arrests.
3	MS. LEBOEUF:
4	Oh, well, then
5	MR. LAYRISSON:
6	On No. 28.
7	The question that I have is the year of service.
8	MR. SCHEXNAYDER:
9	Yes.
10	MS. LEBOEUF:
11	Oh, yes, yes, because it's been longer than five
12	years, so he's not
13	MR. LAYRISSON:
14	Well, P.O.S.T
15	MS. LEBOEUF:
16	P.O.S.T. certified him in September. Well, I wouldn't
17	think he would be eligible until April of or September
18	the 13th, right or April?
19	MR. LAYRISSON:
20	I'll make a motion that we verify with P.O.S.T. that
21	he is P.O.S.T. certified, that all he needed was the
22	refresher that he has taken, and then we'll put him on the
23	defer it to the next meeting once we get that answer.
24	CHIEF CALLAIS:
25	I mean, I can provide to you the letter that we had

received from P.O.S.T. 1 MR. LAYRISSON: 2 I think he got real lucky with that, Chief, because 3 when I look at, he should have been required to do the full 4 5 P.O.S.T. 6 MS LEBOEUF: 7 Uh-huh. MR. LAYRISSON: 8 But, either way, he still has to have a year of 9 service because of his lapse. If he had come from another 10 department, he would be fine, but due to the fact that he 11 hasn't been in law enforcement since '99, he's going to 12 have to do a year of service before he can get it, even 13 though he's P.O.S.T. certified. 14 CHIEF CALLAIS: 15 16 Right. MS. LEBOEUF: 17 Right, correct, that's correct. 18 19 CHIEF CALLAIS: And that date would be the date of --20 MR. LAYRISSON: 21 His hire date, April. It will be back -- he'll be 22 back -- on the February 7th meeting, he'll be on the 23 agenda, because we'll have the answer from P.O.S.T. and --24 everything I see, I think he's going to have to wait until 25

1 his hire date. 2 MR. LAYRISSON: 3 The job title really don't matter as long as they are a commissioned, as long as it's with arrest authority, 4 because we always had I.A. guys, and, you know --5 6 MR. SCHEXNAYDER: 7 Right. 8 MS. RYLAND: My question is, I didn't think the break mattered, as 9 10 long as he had a year of prior service. I thought it was 11 only the P.O.S.T. certification for the five years. Paul? 12 13 MR. SCHEXNAYDER: I don't see anything. 14 I'm looking. 15 MS. RYLAND: As long as they had a year of prior service, no matter 16 17 if it was 20 years ago, but as long as they had the time --I mean, I may be wrong, I'm not positive -- as long as it 18 was eligible prior service, and if that's true, he will 19 20 actually be eligible back to the P.O.S.T. date. MS. LEBOEUF: 21 22 To the P.O.S.T. date, right, to September, that's 23 correct. 24 MR. LAYRISSON: When he got the refresher. 25

1	MS. LEBOEUF:
2	When he got the refresher, yes.
3	MR. SCHEXNAYDER:
4	Yes. I don't see where it really matters with the
5	money requirement.
6	MS. RYLAND:
7	So do you still want to defer, or do you
8	MR. LAYRISSON:
9	No. I'd like to rescind that motion, and
10	MS. RYLAND:
11	So, if we get the letter, the refresher letter
12	MR. LAYRISSON:
13	If we get the refresher letter I mean, he provided
14	us with the certificate. Let's just verify that is
15	P.O.S.T. certified, and if he is, then I say we give him
16	back pay until the date of his certificate.
17	MS. RYLAND:
18	So I can go ahead and put him on?
19	MR. LAYRISSON:
20	Yes.
21	MS. LEBOEUF:
22	And I'll second that motion.
23	MR. LAYRISSON:
24	Thank you, that was good. He'll be happy.
25	MS. LEBOEUF:

He'll be happy. 1 CHIEF CALLAIS: 3 Yes. I'm going to try to text him. If he's got that letter, he can send it back. 4 MS. LEBOEUF: He can fax it. 6 MR. LAYRISSON: 7 8 Yes. MS. LEBOEUF: 9 Yes, because they won't do anything until closer to 10 the end of the month, so as long as he does it in the next 11 few weeks, you know, he'll be good. 12 2013 MEETING SCHEDULE 13 MR. LAYRISSON: 14 All right. The next item on the agenda is the 2013 15 16 meeting schedule. 17 MS. RYLAND: An FYI. I was asked to have the dates ready. 18 MR. LAYRISSON: 19 I have been getting a lot of requests for this, as 20 well, so that is why we wanted it on the agenda. A lot of 21 the departments are wanting to have it all for the year. 22 MS. LEBOEUF: 23 It looks good to me. I mean, you know, we'll have to 24 wait until the -- a little bit -- just a hair closer. 25

6	MR. LAYRISSON:
