21	MR.	LAYRISSON:
22		The next item is under new business, Act 110.
23	MS.	RYLAND:
24		There is a current Act 110 list that we will be
25	subr	mitting with your approval to the JOCB Committee. We

will have the additional application that you just 1. 2 approved with Tammy Bushnell. 3 MS. LEBOEUF: Oh, to add to it? 4 MS. RYLAND: 5 6 If you agree to approve her, also. 7 MS. LEBOEUF: 8 Gosh, that Robinson is \$10,000. MR. LAYRISSON: 9 10 Mr. Schexnayder, do you see any problem with our 11 Act 110 requests? 12 MR. SCHEXNAYDER: 13 Well, we looked at the law in this respect, and it 14 appears that the Board just certifies that back pay is 15 required, and then it's up to the legislative committee, it's in their discretion to approve it. So I don't think 16 17 we have a choice. It said the Board shall certify that 18 such payment is due, that they are due. 19 MR. LAYRISSON: 20 All right. So, basically, whether we approve it or 21 not, they still have to fund it? 22 MR. SCHEXNAYDER: 23 Well, they have the discretion. 24 MS. RYLAND:

## 1 MR. SCHEXNAYDER: The law gives the Joint Legislative Committee 2 discretion to approve it. This Board -- it seems like the 3 job of this Board is to determine whether it's due or not. 4 5 If it's due, it's due, and you certify it to them that 6 it's due. 7 MS. LEBOEUF: 8 We're request they approve it, and they either do one or the other? 9 10 MR. SCHEXNAYDER: It appears to give them the discretion, but it 11 12 doesn't appear to give the Board the discretion, so we just determine whether or not it's due. 13 MS. LEBOEUF: 14 15 So, for instance, Mr. Robinson who has been working 16 since 2010, and they just didn't submit it, we don't have 17 an option --18 MR. SCHEXNAYDER: 19 Right. 20 MS. LEBOEUF: 21 -- as to request that the Committee approves the 22 \$10,000 for him? 23 MR. SCHEXNAYDER: 24 Right. The law just says that if it's due and 25 eligible, the Board shall certify it.

7		Within the \$10,000 limit.

MR. LAYRISSON: 1 2 All right. Billing? 3 MS. RYLAND: 4 Okay. You'll see in your packet that there is an 5 attached spreadsheet of all of the current outstanding 6 billing for every police department or Marshal's Office. This is as of yesterday. We have been receiving a lot of 7 8 payments because we sent out a final notice to all of the 9 departments last month. It went out with the warrant, so 10 there was no excuse for anybody to not receive their final 11 notices, second notices, or current billing that are owed 12 to them. 13 We have a lot of people asking why we haven't taken 14 the pay from people if they are currently working at 15 another department, that are no longer working today at 16 Ponchatoula that were working at Maringouin or somewhere, 17 but I talked to Paul and we can't do that. So, if it's 18 owed from a department, the department is going to have to 19 pay back the money. 20 MR. LAYRISSON: 21 Okay. Then New Orleans, those 178,000 --22 MS. RYLAND: 23 Well, they have two different invoices that total 24 almost \$200,000, so... 25 MR. SCHEXNAYDER:

10		Well, some of this is ten years old. We're trying to
11	get	it all cleaned up and taken care of.

15		Are some of them refusing to pay?
16	MS.	RYLAND:
17		That's on the fire side. We'll talk about that later.
18	MR.	SCHEXNAYDER:

21		Obviously, all of them are refusing to pay. We
22	have	en't collected yet.
23	MS.	RYLAND:
24		We haven't heard any police refusals yet. Most of
25	ther	m have already called.

2	Now we haven't seen any checks yet.
3	MS. RYLAND:
4	Yes, right.
5	MR. LAYRISSON:
6	You mentioned Ponchatoula, but I don't see them
7	anywhere on this list.
8	MS. RYLAND:
9	No.
10	NEW APPLICATIONS SUBMITTED FOR APPROVAL
11	MR. LAYRISSON:
12	All right. Are we ready to look at new applications
13	submitted for approval.
14	MS. LEBOEUF:
15	Not a whole lot of 110, finally, maybe they are
16	getting it, maybe not.
17	MS. RYLAND:
18	It's early in the year.
19	MS. LEBOEUF:
20	I know.
21	MR. SCHEXNAYDER:
22	The last one on the list, that's not correct, is it?
23	MS. RYLAND:
24	They suspended her.
25	MR SCHEXNAYDER:

1	I was just wondering how her salary just that's an
2	annual salary, right? I mean, everybody else is monthly.
3	I just noticed the salary was way off.
