3	MR. LAYRISSON:
4	I would like to call this meeting to order on
5	February 13th, at 10:10 a.m., for the Supplemental Pay
6	Board.
7	APPROVAL OF MINUTES OF MEETING - NOVEMBER 14, 2013
8	MR. LAYRISSON:
9	The first item on the agenda is the approval of the
10	minutes from the November 14th, meeting.
11	MS. LEBOUEF:
12	I will make a motion to aproved.
13	MS. HUTCHINSON:
14	I'll second.
15	MR. LAYRISSON:
16	We have a motion and a second.
17	Anyone opposed?
18	(No response.)
19	No, so the motion carries.
20	NEW BUSINESS
21	<u> Covington Police Department - Tammy Bushnell</u>
22	MR. LAYRISSON:
23	The next item on the agenda, Covington Police
24	Department, Tammy Bushnell.
25	MS. RYLAND:

Okay. At our last meeting, Ms. Bushnell was approved 1 for her application as a dispatcher, and she was also 2 approved with Act 110 money downtown with the legislature. 3 We're bringing her back before the Board because we 4 didn't an audit of all of the warrants, and we noticed 5 that her job title was a police records clerk. 6 So we asked for more information from Covington 7 Police Department on her job title and a job description. 8 At that time, we were then notified that her job title had 9 10 again changed back to a dispatcher. 11 So, giving you some more detail on her, when her application was submitted to us, she was actually holding 12 the title of a police records clerk. She was not a 13 dispatcher at this time. So she was ineligible to receive 14 supplemental pay from April of 2013, to January of 2014, 15 under the title of police records clerk, but she can pick 16 17 back up as a dispatcher in January of this year. MR. LAYRISSON: 18 19 Does she have arrest authority? 20 MR. SCHEXNAYDER: 21 Well, the law specifically applied to dispatchers. 22 MS. RYLAND: Dispatchers, they don't have to have that. 23 MR. SCHEXNAYDER: 24 25 No.

MS. LEBOEUF: 1 Okay. So when is she eligible? 2 MS. RYLAND: 3 4 She was eligible in her dispatcher position when she submitted her application, but then she was not eligible 5 in her police records clerk. 6 MS. LEBOEUF: 7 There's a piece in the middle where she she's not? 8 MS. RYLAND: 9 Yes. We did not pay her her Act 110 money because we 10 wanted to make sure of the correct dates and everything. 11 12 MS. HUTCHINSON: 13 So her Act 110 money --14 MS. RYLAND: 15 She was due \$10,000, but -- based on her inaccurate application at the time. 16 17 MS. HUTCHINSON: Because at that time, it said that she was a 18 19 dispatcher? 20 MS. RYLAND: We thought the entire timeframe. So then, when we 21 22 got all the corrected dates and all of the correct PAF's, she's only due \$5,417 of the \$10,000 because she was 23 24 overpaid for the timeframe where she was a police records 25 clerk.

1	MS. HUTCHINSON:
2	Got you.
3	MS. RYLAND:
4	But now she can begin receiving again I mean,
5	she's received the whole time because we never took her off
6	because they never took her off.
7	MS. LEBOEUF:
8	They never took her off the warrant?
9	MS. RYLAND:
10	Correct.
11	MS. HUTCHINSON:
12	Did you deduct that?
13	MS. RYLAND:
14	Correct. She's not getting the total amount of
15	\$10,000. She's only getting the \$5,417.
16	MS. HUTCHINSON:
17	So the Act 110 money has not been actually disbursed
18	to her?
19	MS. RYLAND:
20	Correct.
21	MS. HUTCHINSON:
22	Okay.
23	MS. RYLAND:
24	I just wanted to make sure you all were okay with
25	that.

1	MS.	LEBOEUF :
2		But we don't she doesn't owe us any regular
3	sup	plemental pay back?
4	MS.	RYLAND:
5		No. We're deducting that from her Act 110.
6	MS.	LEBOEUF:
7		Got you.
8	MS.	HUTCHINSON:
9		Okay.
10	MS.	LEBOEUF:
11		Are you okay with that?
12	MS.	HUTCHINSON:
13		Yes.
14	MR.	LAYRISSON:
15		So do we need a motion, or are we all okay with that?
16	Do 1	we need a motion?
17	MR.	SCHEXNAYDER:
18		You probably need a motion.
19	MR.	LAYRISSON:
20		All right. I'll entertain a motion to
21	MS.	HUTCHINSON:
22		I'll make a motion to approve the adjusted amount of
23	\$5,	417.
24	MS.	LEBOEUF:
25		I'll second it.

MR. LAYRISSON: 1 2 Any opposed? (No response.) 3 4 The motion carries. Sulphur Police Department 5 6 Jennifer Young MR. LAYRISSON: 7 8 The next item on the agenda, the Sulphur Police Department, Jennifer Young and Melanie Burleson. 9 10 MS. RYLAND: Okay. While also performing our audit, these two 11 12 ladies also came up as police records clerks. MR. SCHEXNAYDER: 13 14 Are they still clerks? 15 MS. RYLAND: 16 Yes. 17 MS. LEBOEUF: 18 And have always been clerks? MS. RYLAND: 19 20 Now -- no. 21 MS. LEBOEUF: 22 No. She was a communications officer. 23 MS. RYLAND: 24 Yes. Jennifer Young started out in '05, as a 25 communications officer, but has since been a records clerk

for years. Now, with Jennifer Young, she should not have 1 2 been put on. This was an oversight. MS. LEBOEUF: 3 4 She wasn't eligible as a communications officer? MS. RYLAND: 5 She was not eligible as a police records clerk when 6 7 her application was submitted. 8 MS. LEBOEUF: So was she eligible --9 10 MS. RYLAND: We pulled her application --11 12 MS. LEBOEUF: Okay. So her application said police records clerk. 13 14 It did not say communication officer? 15 MS. RYLAND: 16 Correct. 17 MS. LEBOEUF: 18 Even though she was a communications officer back in 19 2005? 20 MS. RYLAND: 21 Correct. When her application was submitted, she was 22 a police records clerk in 2010. 23 MS. HUTCHINSON: 24 She was never supposed to receive supplemental pay? 25 MS. RYLAND:

She was put on the spreadsheet as a police No. 1 2 officer. 3 MS. HUTCHINSON: On the warrant that they submitted? 4 MS. RYLAND: 5 On the spreadsheet that we do, so she was entered as 6 a police officer in the system. 7 8 MS. LEBOUEF: She has always been a police records clerk? 9 10 MS. RYLAND: 11 Correct. MR. LAYRISSON: 12 And is it our mistake, or --13 14 MS. RYLAND: 15 Yes, yes. MS. LEBOEUF: 16 Oh, gosh. 17 18 MR. LAYRISSON: Okay. So it's our mistake, I don't believe we can do 19 20 anything but --21 MS. LEBOEUF: But stop it, right? 22 MR. LAYRISSON: 23 24 Right. MS. RYLAND: 25

She needs to come off. 1 2 MR. LAYRISSON: 3 Yes. 4 MS. RYLAND: 5 Yes. MR. SCHEXNAYDER: 6 How did we make the mistake? They applied and we 7 8 just didn't catch it? 9 MS. RYLAND: 10 Yes. 11 MR. LAYRISSON: 12 And that's prior to my service on the Board. 13 MS. HUTCHINSON: 14 Prior to mine, too. MS. LEBOEUF: 15 16 Everybody's. 17 Are they both the same situation? She would just --18 I guess we better do them separate. 19 MS. RYLAND: 20 That's Jennifer Young. 21 MR. SCHEXNAYDER: 22 Let's do them separate. MS. LEBOEUF: 23 24 Yes. We can do them separate. 25 MR. LAYRISSON:

1 Yes. 2 Sulphur Police Department Melanie Burleson 3 4 MS. RYLAND: Okay. Melanie applied as a communications officer. 5 Sulphur just did not let us know when her job title 6 7 changed to a police records clerk. 8 MS. HUTCHINSON: We're on from --9 MS. RYLAND: 10 You all want to finish Jennifer first? 11 12 MR. SCHEXNAYDER: 13 Yes, let' do that. 14 Jennifer Young 15 MS. HUTCHINSON: 16 I'll make a motion to suspend her supplemental pay based on the fact that she is not in an eligible position. 17 18 MS. LEBOEUF: 19 I'll second that. MR. LAYRISSON: 20 The motion carries. 21 22 (Off-the-record discussion.) 23 Melanie Burleson 24 MR. LAYRISSON: 25 Now we'll move on to Melanie.

1	MS. LEBOEUF:
2	Melanie.
3	MR. LAYRISSON:
4	Melanie was a communications officer
5	MS. LEBOEUF:
6	Was Melanie our fault, or Melanie was their fault?
7	MS. RYLAND:
8	Their fault for not letting us know her job title had
9	changed.
10	MS. HUTCHINSON:
11	Changed, okay, so when did it change?
12	MS. RYLAND:
13	2012.
14	MS. HUTCHINSON:
15	So can we then have them to repay our money?
16	MR. SCHEXNAYDER:
17	We can try. We've been trying, right? I mean, not
18	this one, but the others?
19	MR. RYLAND:
20	Covington owes money, and he was in the new chief's
21	money we went to on Monday. I mean, I can if you all want
22	me to.
23	MS. HUTCHINSON:
24	Yes, because
25	MR. LAYRISSON:

If they don't properly notify us, they should be held 1 2 responsible. MS. HUTCHINSON: 3 4 Right, and they are submitting the --MS. LEBOEUF: 5 Oh, this is Sulphur. 6 7 MS. RYLAND: I was thinking the last one. They failed to properly 8 notify us. 9 10 MS. HUTCHINSON: So was the warrant submitted correctly? 11 12 MS. RYLAND: 13 I don't know. We'll have to go back and see. We'll 14 check it to be sure before we bill, but --15 MS. HUTCHINSON: 16 Okay. I'll make a motion to suspend her supplemental pay based on that she is not in an eligible job title, and 17 also to attempt to recoup payment if it was, indeed, not 18 submitted correctly on the warrant. 19 20 MS. LEBOEUF: 21 I'll second it. 22 MR. LAYRISSON: 23 Okay. 24 LEGAL MATTERS 25 MR. LAYRISSON:

1 The next item on the agenda, legal matters? 2 MR. SCHEXNAYDER: 3 I think we just took care of them all. 4 MS. LEBOEUF: How convenient was that? 5 NEW APPLICATIONS SUBMITTED FOR APPROVAL 6 7 MR. LAYRISSON: Under new applications, we have 154. 8 MS. LEBOEUF: 9 10 Golly, it's a bunch. MS. HUTCHINSON: 11 I'm sure they're old. 12 13 MR. LAYRISSON: I think Baton Rouge graduated an academy. 14 15 MS. LEBOEUF: 16 True. 17 MS. HUTCHINSON: 18 I guess because they all have prior experience, that 19 they don't -- their hire date was 2/18. 20 MS. LEBOEUF: Wow. Act 110 is only \$300, a miracle. 21 22 MS. HUTCHINSON: 23 No. Look at this one. 24 MS. LEBOEUF: 25 Yes, I know. It's so low.

MS. HUTCHINSON: 1 2 No. Look at the --3 MR. SCHEXNAYDER: The one out of Golden Meadow. 4 5 MS. LEBOEUF: 6 Yes. Is that right on Natchitoches? Prior service, 7 4/6/97 to '07, we've got to give him credit for that? His P.O.S.T. was in '97, wow. 8 9 MS. HUTCHINSON: He's doesn't have a five-year break? 10 11 MS. LEBOEUF: 12 No, he didn't. It's got to be right under it. 13 MS. HUTCHINSON: Well, he's just going back to '12, August '12, right? 14 15 MS. LEBOEUF: Yes. I'm just -- \$5,400. 16 17 Gosh, New Orleans hired a bunch. 18 MS. HUTCHINSON: 19 Okay. Like the people from New Orleans, though, some 20 of them look like they were hired on 4/21/13, so he must 21 have prior experience, right, and not just some new --MS. LEBOEUF: 22 23 Yes, but they're not effective to 4/21/14. 24 MS. RYLAND: 25 Right, so that means they didn't have any.

1 MS. HUTCHINSON: So we're just going ahead -- okay. 2 MS. LEBOEUF: 3 We're just approving them based on the application we 4 5 received, not as though the date is now. 6 MS. HUTCHINSON: Based on the application we received? 7 8 MS. RYLAND: 9 Correct. 10 MR. SCHEXNAYDER: What was that? 11 12 MS. LEBOEUF: 13 Some of the dates are in the future. 14 MR. SCHEXNAYDER: 15 Wow. Are you sure that's not a typo? MS. RYLAND: 16 I don't know. 17 18 MR. SCHEXNAYDER: I've never seen anything close to that. 19 MS. LEBOEUF: 20 Who is it? 21 22 MR. SCHEXNAYDER: 23 The guy out of Rayville. 24 His first name is C-Z-Y-Z. 25 MS. LEBOEUF:

Okay. Are you all ready? 1 2 MS. HUTCHINSON: 3 Yes. 4 MS. LEBOEUF: I'll make a motion to approve the new applications. 5 6 MS. HUTCHINSON: 7 I'll second. 8 MR. LAYRISSON: 9 Motion carries. 10 SET TIME AND ATE OF NEXT MEETING 11 MR. LAYRISSON: 12 All right. We have our next meeting tentatively set 13 for June 5th, at 10:00 a.m. 14 BUDGET MATTERS 15 MS. HUTCHINSON: 16 Can we go back to budget matters? There is no issues at this point since we're not having another meeting until 17 18 June 5th. Session will be over at that point, so is there 19 a budget pending? MS. LEBOEUF: 20 21 Uh-huh. 22 MS. RYLAND: 23 No. 24 MS. HUTCHINSON: Can you send me a projection, like just a projection 25

1	so	we can see where we are?
2	MS.	RYLAND:
3		Yes, got it. I can do that.
4	MS.	HUTCHINSON:
5		Okay.
6		ADJOURN
7	MR.	LAYRISSON:
8		I would like to entertain a motion to adjourn.
9	MS.	LEBOEUF:
10		I'll make that motion.
11	MS.	HUTCHINSON:
12		I'll second.
13	MR.	LAYRISSON:
14		Motion carries. It's unanimous.
