## LA WORKERS' COMPENSATION SECOND INJURY BOARD

Meeting of April 5, 2018

The regular meeting of the Second Injury Board convened at 2:00 p.m.

The Chairman moved to *Item 5* on the agenda, being the recommendation to approve reimbursement of (241) partial payments beginning with Claim #84-0455 and ending with Claim #16-0517. A request was made for settlement authority by the Chapter 7 Trustee representing LA Safety Association of Timbermen. Mr. Kopfinger gave a presentation to the Board and requested they approve the settlement authority request of the carrier representative. Mr. Hansberry asked for a recommendation from staff to which Ms. Trahant responded with a recommendation to discuss the claim in Executive Session. Mr. Kopfinger then left the room so the Board could enter Executive Session.

Mr. Hansberry asked for a motion to go into Executive Session to discuss Second Injury Board litigation and settlements. Mr. Hawkland made the motion. It was seconded by Ms. Mack and it passed unanimously.

Upon returning from Executive Session, the Chairman moved to *Item 8a* of the agenda, being settlement recommendations. The Chairman then requested a motion to approve the recommendations of the Acting Director regarding settlement authority as discussed in Executive Session and to extend settlement authority to be reimbursed on quarterly basis for the following (15) claims.
