## LA WORKERS' COMPENSATION SECOND INJURY BOARD

Meeting of August 5, 2021

The regular meeting of the Second Injury Board convened at 2:06 p.m.

Mr. Lee made note that the Board was holding the meeting through video/teleconference pursuant to John Bel Edwards' Executive Order #84-2020, Section 2c.

Mr. Hansberry called the meeting to order and began with amending the agenda to allow Mr. John Schweitzer to give the LA Rehabilitation Services (LRS) presentation. Mr. Schweitzer began by recognizing the 10<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the collaboration between the Second Injury Board and LRS in which up to one percent of the Fund's annual budget may be approved by the Board to be allocated to LRS (LA R.S. 23:1377 (G). Allocated funds receive a match of 3.781% by federal funds. Over the past decade, LRS has invested over 25 million dollars in success stories. Mr. Schweitzer explained the goal of the program is to help people with disabilities obtain or retain employment. LRS has eight regional offices throughout the state, each with a single point of contact, to assist employees with their services. Mr. Schweitzer provided the following data regarding the prior year: the allocation was \$2,511,737.00; LRS opened 357 cases; there were 669 closures with 631 successfully employed; LRS provided 1026 total services; the average cost per case was less than \$2,500.00.

Mr. Hansberry questioned if LRS was serving all 64 parishes. Mr. Schweitzer confirmed they are. Prior to exiting the meeting, Mr. Schweitzer concluded his presentation by thanking the Board for their cooperation in the past and consideration for the coming year. The Board then discussed the recommendation of the Director to allocate .9% (approximately \$535,000.00) for FY21-22. Ms. Faber made a motion to accept the recommendation of the Director. Mr. Coulter seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

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The Chairman moved to *Item 1* on the agenda, being the reading of the minutes from the previous meeting of July 1, 2021. Mr. Hansberry asked for motion to dispense with the reading of the minutes and approve the minutes as printed and distributed. The motion was made by Mr. Hawkland, seconded by Ms. Faber, and passed unanimously.

Mr. Hansberry moved to *Item 2* on the agenda, Hearing Requests. There was no hearing listed.
