Meeting of December 06, 2018

The Chairman moved to *Item 9*, any other matters to discuss, Ms. Trahant gave an update from Louisiana Rehabilitation Services. To date there have been 261 closures with 241 being successful. Currently there are 255 open cases. To date there have been 516 individuals assisted by LRS at a total cost of \$1,348,820.00 averaging \$2,614.00 per person.

There were then no other matters to discuss. The Chairman asked for a motion to adjourn. Mr. Hawkland moved to adjourn. The motion was seconded by Ms. Mack and passed unanimously.
