Currently there are 289 open cases. There have been 675 employees served. SIB funding and Federal drawdown totals \$1,911,276.00 averaging \$2,800.00 per case.

There were then no other matters to discuss. The Chairman asked for a motion to adjourn. Mr. Coulter moved to adjourn. The motion was seconded by Ms. Mack and passed unanimously.
