LA WORKERS' COMPENSATION SECOND INJURY BOARD

Meeting of July 8, 2020

The regular meeting of the Second Injury Board convened at 2:02 p.m.

Ms. Trahant made note that the meeting was being held through video/teleconference pursuant to John Bel Edwards' Executive Order #52-2020, Section 4, Paragraph E.

Mr. Hansberry called the meeting to order and began with *Item 1* on the agenda, being the reading of the minutes from the previous meeting of June 4, 2020.
