The motion was made by Mr. Coulter, seconded by Mr. Hawkland and passed unanimously.

The Chairman moved to Item 9, asking if there were any other matters to discuss.

Item 9a addressed the 2017 SIF Assessment Rate recommendation. Ms. Trahant made a recommendation to increase the assessment rate to 6.75% due to a lower amount of paid benefits being reported. The increase will allow SIB to maintain a 1 year timeframe in reimbursements. The motion was made by Mr. Coulter to accept the assessment recommendation of the Acting Director, seconded by Mr. Hawkland, and passed unanimously.

Item 9b, SIF Knowledge Questionnaire, was the next issue to be addressed. Ms. Trahant brought to the attention of the Board changes to the SIF Knowledge Questionnaire designed to assist in keeping employees' personal information confidential. Mr. Hansberry suggested making a change in the 1st paragraph from "your benefits" to "your workers' compensation benefits". Mr. Coulter moved to accept the changes. The motion was seconded by Mr. Hawkland and passed unanimously.

There were then no other matters to discuss. The Chairman asked for a motion to adjourn. Mr. Hawkland moved to adjourn. The motion was seconded by Ms. Mack and passed unanimously.
