a. 2023 SIB Annual Assessment

Staff presented an informative report regarding the SIB budget and legislative appropriations. Staff also made a recommendation to set the SIB annual assessment rate at 7.25%, which remains unchanged from last year.

Upon motion of Mr. Hawkland, seconded by Ms. Kirby, the motion unanimously passed, and the 2023 SIB annual assessment rate of 7.25% was approved.

b. **LCTA**

Ms. Terrel Thomas, attorney for LCTA Casualty Insurance Company (LCTA), requested that the acquisition of LCTA by an unidentified insurer be discussed. Ms. Thomas further requested that the SIB Director be granted authority to sign a compromise agreement on behalf of the Board.

After discussions regarding the purchaser, Mr. Hawkland made a motion to deny any authority be delegated to the SIB Director to contract/settle with LCTA on the Board's behalf. The motion was seconded by Ms. Kirby, and it passed unanimously.
