- Stacey Alexius reports that AWS is Amazon Web Services, a cloud-based computing platform. They are seeking 2 IBCs to add to the state list: a foundational one and an associate level. The curriculum is free. The certification cost is \$150. The associate level is considered an advanced level because there will be some pregreuisite courses required. Various LCTCS colleges offer these.
- Melissa Lacour presents on LCTCS connection.
 - Jessica Vallelungo notes that we do have school systems especially in new orelans that are ready to re-skill their teachers. Some are posied to connect with post-secondary partners ready to do this work.

Guest Speaker: Kate Fessler/Adam Lukoskie/Jessica Elliott

- Adam Lukoskie National Retail Federation. He notes that they are specifically seeking the business of retail certification. Some of the others are already approved.
- Ms. Vallelungo states that it is not unmanageable to upskill teachers to offer this curriculum for 28 hours.

- Ms. Taylor-White asks whether this is positioned as advanced? We have required far more than 28 hours for an advanced designation.
 - o Mr. Lukoskie responds that our primary interest is that young people graduating have the skills.
 - o Ms. Taylor-White notes it may be more appropriate as a basic certification.
- Chairman St. Etienne inquires as to how he can feel comfortable that this is not feeding a low wage pipeline?
 - o Mr. Lukoskie answers that wages can vary significantly in different markets. Big retail has jumped recently in their starting wages.
