#### 3. Discussion of FAA Recertification

- a. Ms. Vallelungo explains that this is a book test for the pilot license to fly drones, focused on the laws of air travel. Ms. Polozola ensures that flight time is occurring but there is no oversight to show that a student can effectively fly a drone. Included in the IBCC meeting packet is the data showing the completion rate.
- b. Mr. Reine would like to change the name as the title may be misleading.
- c. Ms. Schowen recommends bundling this certification with the test that requires flight time.
- d. Dr. Vosper suggests perhaps incorporating the oversight into the recertification process. We can conditionally approve the recertification until there is data to show the required flight times are being met.
- 4. Mr. Louis Reine moves to accept the FAA recertification.
  - a. Dr. Vosper seconds
  - b. Mr. Reine withdraws the motion.
- 5. Ms. Schowen moves to conditionally approve recertification with the stipulation that they bundle this credential with the flight test.
