Meeting Minutes

١. Call to order

Chairman David St. Etienne called to order the regular meeting of the Industry Based Certification Committee at 9:32 am on Zoom, at 1001 N. 23rd Street, Baton Rouge January 11, 2022, Louisiana 70804 Large Executive Conference Room.

- Executive Director Jawanda Givens read a portion of the La. R.S. 42:17.1 Certification:
 - On March 11, 2020, in Executive Proclamation 25 JBE 2020, Governor John Bel Edwards declared a state of emergency for Louisiana due to COVID-19. The state of emergency was extended in subsequent Executive Proclamations with the most recent extension in 235 JBE 2021 on December 22, 2021. The state of emergency is a public health one and an in-person meeting of the HR 118 Task Force hosted at the Louisiana Workforce Commission would be detrimental to the health, safety, or welfare of the public.
 - In accordance with Louisiana Revised Statute 42:17.1, the presiding officer of the HR 118 Task Force, Meridith J. Trahant, hereby certifies that the agenda of the meeting is limited to 1) matters that, if they are delayed, will cause curtailment of vital public services or severe economic dislocation and hardship and 2) matters that are critical to continuation of business of the Louisiana Workforce Commission and are not able to be postponed due to other deadlines that cannot be postponed or delayed.
 - As such, in accordance with Louisiana Revised Statute 42:17.1, the HR 118 IBCC meeting on Tuesday, January 11, 2022 at 9:30 AM will be held by video conference and in a manner that allows for observation and input by members of the public in accordance with the provisions of the Louisiana Open Meetings law.

Comments: questions about whether costs of offering IBCs may affect whether an IBC is offered in a certain area.

How can groups promote underutilized IBCs in areas of need?

Jessica noted that sometimes Perkins V funds can help in these expensive programs.

Often training of educators is another issue.

How can the school system justify the cost of a teacher with only a few students enrolled in the class? Can they get a diploma without the full certification?

If for some reason, it is impossible due to relocation, to complete an IBC, there are BESE waivers available to ensure a student can still graduate.

- Prior to voting on the recertification applications, Jessica Vallelungo questions the structure of the AWS welding IBC.
 - o Kellie Taylor-White believes this had something to do with ABC being the only one offering it at the time.
 - o Susie Schowen believes there was a reason why some schools were offering modified versions of it when it was approved.
 - o Mr. Reine understands that ABC Pelican is not certifying, AWS is. It should be AWS whether or not ABC is using it.
 - o Susie Schowen notes that IBCC has tried to avoid specifying training providers and stick to approving the credential itself. It should not matter who is providing the training as long as the students are learning what they need to get the credential.
 - Kellie Taylor-White asks whether this should be edited to AWS rather than specifying ABC Pelican?
 - Jessica Vallelungo suggests that the IBCC identify what qualifies as basic and what is advanced.
 - Mr. Reine recommends that basic should be flat and anything beyond that is advanced.
 - Bill Tulak suggests that IBCC identify exactly what AWS certificate ABC is handing
 - Susie Schowen asks Bill Tulak and Jessica to take a look at this offline and come back with clarification language.
- IBCC will vote on it as is for this meeting's purposes.

AWS- should be listed as AWS certification not ABC Pelican Position and process are two different things but they overlap. Jessica will refer to AWS and determine the actual levels from AWS.
