## 8. Director's Report

Tim LaFleur reported that the roofing underlayment on the terminal building is nearly complete. He also reported that the title transfers on the donated vehicles is complete.

## 9. Engineer's Report

Chuck Stutes reported that they worked on some issues on the AWOS. They have been working on the revised ALP.

The apron project has been delayed considerably due to rain, but have been making a lot of progress the last couple of weeks. They are doing some preliminary work on lights.

The terminal building roof underlayment is almost complete. We should see brick going up soon. The generator has been delivered.
