LA Board of Regents Update:

2015-2016 Simulation Project.

Dr. Shelia Chauvin reviewed the LASimFD 2015-16 report entitled "Establishing a Sustainability Model for the Louisiana Statewide Simulation Faculty Development Program (LaSimFD)" Points of discussion:

- Formalize the Leadership Team
- Develop sustainability model to promote faculty development across the state
- Maintain rigor with train-the-trainer
- LASimFD Leadership Team meetings will continue to be conducted via teleconference
- The Leadership Team will function as hub to coordinate, collaborate, and match the institution to the course facilitator and program evaluator

- The Leadership Team will submit evidence to support expansion
- If an institution expresses interest in faculty development courses, the institution will manage marketing, facility, etc.
- Compensation for course facilitator will be \$300 per course and will be the responsibility of the institution requesting the training
- The Leadership Team will develop policy that incorporates travel and facilitator fee
- Dr. Shelia Chauvin, Chair and Dr. Jennifer Lemoine, Vice Chair of the LaSimFD will serve three year terms
- Results from train-the-trainer were reviewed: 31 registered and 19 participated. Dr. Chauvin will
 follow up with participants who did not submit required coursework to complete the train-thetrainer courses
- Advertising of FD courses: communication regarding training will be sent twice a year
- Documents under development by the LaSimFD Leadership Team include: an instructor directory, information sheet, and appendix for course descriptions

2016-17 LA Health Works Commission Funding Proposal(s)

Project Title: High Fidelity Simulation-From Classroom to Clinical Practice. Council accepted/supported the proposal in concept but recommended the following revisions: more detailed budget, BSN input/participation, clarification of purpose, evaluation tool, clearly defined terms, and clarification regarding partnering with statewide industry leaders.
