ACT 356 (2009) – Articulation and Transfer

§3162. Statewide Articulation and Transfer Council; creation; purpose; membership; duties and responsibilities. ...C. The council shall, with appropriate faculty consultation: ...
(7) Approve common degree program prerequisites across program areas and course and credit-by-exam equivalencies, and establish passing scores and course and credit equivalencies for exams administered

pursuant to accelerated programs including, but not limited to, the <u>Advanced Placement, International</u> <u>Baccalaureate, and College-Level Examination Program</u>.

§3163. Statewide Articulation and Transfer Agreement.... B. The statewide articulation agreement shall, at a minimum:... (6) Provide for acceptance by postsecondary educational institutions of credits earned in accelerated programs such as dual enrollment and the <u>Advanced Placement</u>, <u>International Baccalaureate</u>, <u>and College-Level Examination programs</u>.
