A. Federal Issues/Updates

Mr. Joubert reported that he's still waiting for the audit report that was done in December. He turned the annual Compliance report to OJJP in March and waiting for a response. Mr. Joubert mentioned that he would let the board know as soon as he gets a response. Mr. Cox informed the board of a new statute that states by December 31, 2021, all detention centers in Louisiana will have to be in compliance when it comes to transferring juveniles who will be tried as an adult. Mr. Cox also mentioned that if you aren't in compliance with the federal statute then the grant money could be blocked. Ms. Menard mentioned that herself and Mr. Cox, along with the a few LCLE staff, will be attending the CJJ Conference in Washington and will meet with a few Congressmen and if anyone has any questions they would like to bring up to contact herself or Mr. Joubert.

B. Juvenile Justice Federal Programs

Mr. Joubert mentioned that the board is still in need of 1 Native American Tribe to be added to the board by the September meeting. If anyone on the board knows someone then feel free to contact him.

C. Governor's Conference and RED Committee Reports

Ms. Menard reported that the conference went well. There were 480 people who pre-registered and 460 who attended. The conference consisted of 15 workshops and had 3 sponsors. Ms. Martin-Kohrs reported that the RED committee met in New Orleans to come up with a plan to meet with the Supreme Court which will take place June 24. She also mentioned that the committee is planning to meet with the Clerk of Court Association in Baton Rouge

D. Reports from JJDP Subcommittees

Chairman Galan wanted to introduce the new board members, Ms. Emma Espenan representing Baton Rouge Parish and Mr. Delarious Stewart representing Washington Parish. Chairman Galan welcomed the new members and invited them to join a committee.
