

Bunches Bend Protection District Meeting Minutes 6/12/2015

11 a.m. East Carroll Parish Courthouse, Police Jury room Second Floor

Minutes recorded. Meeting called to order by President Tap Parker. Commissioners present Tap Parker, Steve Brown, Teddy Schneider, Chad Arey, David Oswalt, Ken Jenkins. Also present was Andy Brister, Connie Gardner, and Andre Wright.

David Oswalt made a motion to approve minutes from May 1, 2015 meeting of the district. Steve Brown gave the district financial report and also handed out the annual financial statements for the BBPD as of and for the year ended December 31, 2014. There were no findings by the independent auditor.

Levee maintenance has been signed by President Tap Parker. The levee contractors are behind schedule due to rain. They are set to begin in 2 to 3 weeks.

Andy Brister is to draw up a cooperative endeavor agreement between East Carroll Parish Police Jury and BBPD regarding the pumping station. Andy Brister presented the commissioners with a rough draft of the agreement.

BBPD celebration event is to be held August 7, 2014 at the LA cotton museum. There will be a press conference at 10 am followed by a helicopter tour to view completed project. At noon a light meal will be served.

Steve Brown made a motion to approve a resolution authorizing the levee and collection of an ad valorem tax of 311 mills and an annual tax to be imposed on a per acre basis on land within the boundaries of the BBPD. Seconded by Ken Jenkins.

Teddy Schneider made a motion to adopt the 2015 millage rates. Seconded by Ken Jenkins.

The restoration of Possum Point haul roads is to be on the agenda for the next meeting.

Steve Brown is to talk to Lee Denny about the road in the bend.
