**2) MINUTES AND FINANCIAL REPORT:**

Motion to approve July minutes and September minutes made by D.P. and seconded by W.G.

Financial statement, monthly bills and salaries presented, J.G. moves to pay bills, J.S. seconds. All vote in favor.

Yearly budget was discussed. Motion made and seconded to approve and annual budget of \$180,000.

Beginning November 2<sup>nd</sup>, bank transfers for official payments will incur a \$.50 fee per transaction. Discussion on how to handle these fees. Fees will be covered as processing fees.

**3) LIST OF GUESTS:**

Jose Llanito and Kelton Hector -requesting promoters license - transferring ownership to Kelton Hector, an amateur fighter. Kelton has been training and fighting under coach Jake Demy for two year, Jake Demy will act as the matchmaker for Kelton's promotions. Kelton plans to promote boxing and kickboxing events, aiming to elevate amateur fighters to the professional level. Jose, an associate is financially contributing to the events, SPC Bail Bonds sponsoring \$50,000 per year. There are concerns about the financial arrangement and the need for a letter of credit tied to Kelton. All concerns were discussed and determined the bond and paperwork need to be verified. A representative from the corporation also must be confirmed alone with a letter from the bank or a letter of credit is required to ensure financial backing.

Prince Miles – requesting to overturn the result of his fight against Kevin Todd due to an eye poke incident which took place on September 20, 2024 at the Texas Club in Baton Rouge. The commission explained that they do not have the authority to overturn the referee's decision. It was suggested that the incident would not hinder his future opportunities as a professional fighter.

Brian Castile and Keon Papillion – Brian requesting promoters license and looking to promote father-son fighting event. Seeing guidance on obtaining a license and the necessary steps involved. Event is planned for early 2020 with potential venues being the casino in Opelousas or the Cajun Dome Convention Center

**4) LICENSE RENEWALS/APPLICATIONS:**

Irma Lanito applied for a promoter's license online and paid the fee. The license is being transferred to Jose Lanito. The application and bone were submitted together online and emails regarding the application were received by Alan & Todd but Todd is currently unavailable due to shoulder surgery.

**5) PAST SHOWS:** Nothing to report on past shows.

**6) UPCOMING SHOWS:** No Specific upcoming shows or old business to discuss.

**7) NEW BUSINESS:** Frustrations were expressed over the leniency shown to non-compliant individuals over the enforcement of safety zone regulations, specifically the requirement for barriers around the ring. A transition period was suggested before enforcing strict actions. R.R. supported the idea of bringing in non-compliant individuals for repercussions. Discussion regarding sending formal warning letter to non-compliant individuals and discussed the possibility of fines or suspensions. Emphasis was made on the need for consistent actions among all commissioners to ensure fairness and effectiveness.
