## Louisiana Department of Education (LDOE) Early Childhood Care and Education Advisory Council Monday, December 7, 2015 Minutes – Official

The December 7, 2015 meeting of the Early Childhood Care and Education (ECCE) Advisory Council was called to order at 1:16 P.M.

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Ms. Loar made a motion to approve the minutes of the November 9, 2015 Early Childhood Care and Education Advisory Council. The Council's response was as follows:

On motion of Ms. Loar, and seconded by Ms. Polito, the Early Childhood Care and Education Advisory Council approved the minutes of the November 9, 2015 meeting of the Council.

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Jenna Conway provided a presentation on the HCR 174 Funding Report consultation, and an update on the Early Childhood Funding Model.

- On motion of Mr. Smith, and seconded by Dr. Burns, the Early Childhood Care and Education Advisory Council endorsed the proposed guiding principles for the implementation of the Early Childhood Funding Model with the following recommendations:
  - The guiding principles should include language that indicates a focus on improving child learning and development.
  - The guiding principles should indicate that current levels of the School Readiness Tax Credits (SRTC) should be maintained and maximized.

- The guiding principles should include clarification that all principles are for the 2016-2017 year.
- The Early Childhood Care and Education Advisory Council should be authorized to form an adhoc working group of Advisory Council members, chaired by Mr. Smith, to study potential budgetary options to fully or partially implement the Early Childhood funding model in 2016-2017, and to report back to the Advisory Council at the January meeting.

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On motion of Mr. Young, and seconded by Ms. Wiggins, and with no further business to come before the Early Childhood Care and Education Advisory Council, the December 7, 2015 meeting of the Early Childhood Care and Education Advisory Council was adjourned at 2:33 P.M.
