April 28, 2026

The Cameron Parish Port Harbor & Terminal District met in regular session on Tuesday, April 28, 2026, at the Port Board Building, Cameron, Louisiana at 5:00 o'clock PM.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Howard Romero.

Joseph Devall, Sr. led the Pledge of Allegiance and Thomas Cox gave the invocation.

There was no public comment.

On the motion of Mr. Cox, seconded by Mr. Joseph Devall, Sr., and carried the board approved the February 26, 2026, regular meeting minutes.

On the motion of Mr. Picou seconded by Mr. Vincent and carried the board approved the treasurer's report.

Mrs. Kim Montie gave a staff report. She discussed with the board the no wake zone ordinance, a few meetings she has attended and the landowners meetings that she hosted. She informed the Board that fuel will be available at the EPS dock pending all necessary approvals.
