February 26, 2026

The Cameron Parish Port Harbor & Terminal District met in regular session on Tuesday, January 20, 2026 at the Port Board Building, Cameron, Louisiana at 5:00 o'clock PM.

There was no public comment.

On the motion of Mr. Cox, seconded by Mr. Picou, and carried the board approved the January 20, 2026 regular meeting minutes.

On the motion of Mrs. Miller seconded by Mr. Morales, and carried the board approved the treasurer's report.

On the motion of Mrs. Miller, seconded by Mr. Morales and carried, the board approved the payment of the February 2026 bills.

The board discussed a resolution authorizing the executive director to submit a letter of mutual agreement to the LA Transportation Authority for the privatization of the Cameron ferry, granting the president authority to sign EPS Notice of Ground Lease Agreement for Tract 1A and Tract 2, granting the president authority to sign EPS Notice of Ground Lease Agreement for Tract 1B, and the GIS Engineering & Design proposal for the North Loop Dock Expansion and Restoration Project, Americas LNG Summit Sponsorship .

On the motion of Mrs. Miller, seconded by Mr. Morales and carried, the board granted the president authority to sign the resolution authorizing the executive director to submit a letter of mutual agreement to the LA Transportation Authority for the privatization of the Cameron ferry.

On the motion of Mr. Savoie, seconded by Mr. Picou, and carried, the board granted the president authority to sign EPS Notice of Ground Lease Agreement for Tract 1A and Tract 2.

On the motion of Mrs. Miller, seconded by Mr. Picou and carried, the board granted the president authority to sign EPS Notice of Ground Lease Agreement for Tract 1B.

On the motion of Mrs. Miller, seconded by Mr. Morales and carried, the board approved the GIS Engineering & Design proposal for the North Loop Dock Expansion and Restoration Project.

On the motion of Mrs. Miller, seconded by Mr. Morales, and carried the board approved the sponsorship for the Americas LNG Summit.

On the motion of Mrs. Miller, seconded by Mr. Vincent and carried the board approved the US Coast Guard Bulletin Ad for \$2,795.00.

Mrs. Kim Montie gave a staff report. She updated the board on Washington DC trip, other meetings and conferences and discussed with the board the expansion of the AOC Park.

The next regular meeting will be scheduled for March 31, 2026 at 5 PM at the Cameron Parish Port Building.

There being no further business and upon motion of Mrs. Miller, seconded by Mr. Vincent and carried, the meeting was declared adjourned.

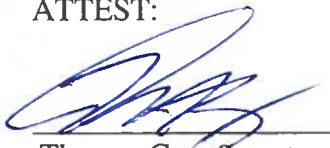
