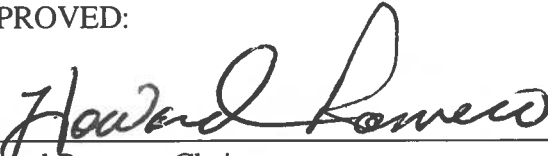

There being no further business and upon motion of Mr. Cox, seconded by Mr. Swire and carried, the meeting was declared adjourned.

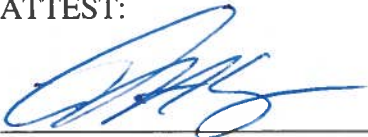
