On the motion of Mr. Savoie seconded by Mr. Joseph Devall, Sr., and carried, the board approved the lowest quote contingent upon obtaining a third quote and contingent upon the extension of the LACRED grant.

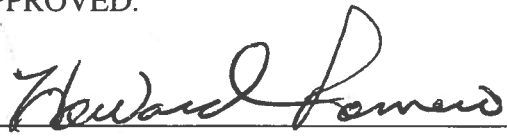
Mrs. Kim Montie gave a staff report. She updated the board on recent local projects.

The next regular meeting will be scheduled for June 30, 2026, at 5 PM at the Cameron Parish Port Building.

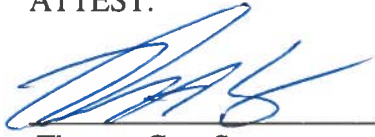
There being no further business and upon motion of Mr. Picou, seconded by Mr. Morales and carried, the meeting was declared adjourned.
