Call to Order

• Approval of the Minutes

Topics of Discussion.

- Written Report Act 354
 - Commission Legal Counsel Lauryn Sudduth presented the proposed written report to the Legislature which was unanimous adopted by the Commission. The Commission authorized the report to be forwarded to the Legislature.

Legislation

Commission Legal Counsel Lauryn Sudduth presented proposed amendments to ACT 354 of the 2018 Regular Session, which included changing the meetings schedule to every four months instead of every three months, and repealing Section 556.B, which mandated that the Office of the Attorney General adopt rules to implement sexual assault collection kit standardization and protocols for forensic medical examinations. It was pointed out that it had been previously determined by legal counsel that the Office of Attorney General does not have the constitutional authority to adopt and enforce such rules. Further the Commission

voted to seek amendment of Act 354, to add the Executive Director of the Sexual Trauma Awareness and Response (STAR) Agency as a member of the Commission

- HSR1 Activity

 Monica Taylor and Morgan Lamandre reported that there had been no HSR1 activity since the last meeting.
