Return to the Regular Meeting for any necessary voting on executive session items

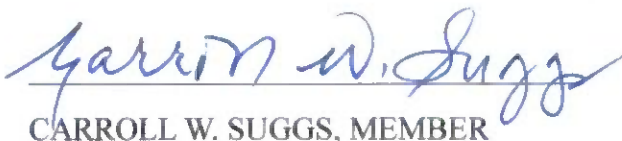

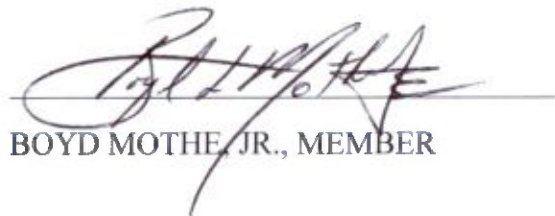
- a. 2025-001-I Fern Park Cemetery, Natchitoches, LA
