ADRD Advisory Subcommittee Meeting Minutes

I. Call to Order

II. Roll Call

III. Opening Remarks

Tatiana Gonzalez Quiroga welcomed all to the meeting of the ADRD Advisory Council Subcommittee.

IV. New Business

Tatiana Gonzalez Quiroga initiated discussion on the need to begin the drafting process for the 2028–2033 ADRD State Plan.

Jason Reed emphasized the importance of establishing measurable outcomes within the plan. He further recommended reviewing other states' plans that clearly articulate measurable outcomes and deliverables to help guide the development process.

Elizabeth Disbrow highlighted the need to secure funding resources necessary for the implementation of the future state plan. Warren Hebert noted that existing relationships with legislative champions could be leveraged to support the plan's advancement. He also underscored the importance of incorporating high-risk populations for dementia, as well as caregivers, into the plan's priorities.

Anne Foundas provided an update on the Rural Health Transformation Grant and noted exploring potential subgrant opportunities connected to this initiative.

The subcommittee agreed that the initial focus for the drafting of the new State Plan will center on early detection, risk reduction, and

diagnosis.

Discussed Deadlines and Next Steps- The subcommittee will meet on February 19, 2026 and focus on early detection, risk reduction and diagnosis for the drafting process.

The subcommittee will present initiatives to the ADRD Council on March 2, 2026.
