Ms. Ceasar moved, which was seconded by Ms. McBride to recognize and approve the above referenced request. The motion was passed without opposition.

III. IMPLEMENTATION TASKS

Mr. Marcello and Mr. Force

1. Counsel's Report Re Veritext-Esquire Settlement Agreement.

The Board to adopt certain policies and practices. Some of the practices have specific deadlines. Others are on-going drafts. The Board has already begun to satisfy some of the obligations, except for the settlement agreement. Board has to adopt Anti-trust Compliance Policy.

2. Chair's Report Re Dismissal of Pending Investigations

Contacting Lenny and Christian and they have informally had conversations as relates to any open investigations, have been directed orally to close those. Will send an email following up with that by close of business today, so we are in compliance with the settlement agreement.

3. Proposed Revision of Rule 1303

Removal of financial disclosures requirement from the Safe Harbor procedure: This removal of language as shown will not impair in the least the Safe Harbor provision which is there to protect court reporters in taking on work, but it will enhance the effectiveness of the Safe Harbor proceedings. The removal of that language will strengthen the Safe Harbor procedure and make it more readily available to court reporters in the future. Mr. Force added that this change reduces the burden on the Board to maintain these records

going forward. Ms. Ware moved, which was seconded by Ms. McBride for provisional approval to initiate rule change. The motion passed without opposition.

4. Proposed Addition to frequently Asked Questions

Under the settlement agreement, Board members have agreed to adopt the formal interpretation of Article 1434. Drafted FAQs in Q&A form of the interpretation of Article. If approved, will be placed on the Website and would formally state the position of the Board. The purpose was for court reporters to read and understand for themselves on the website what they may or may not do. Judge Holmes suggested the Board needed to ensure they easily understood the form before forwarding to AG's office. Mr. Force to rewrite and recirculate. Deferred approval to the next meeting.

5. Consideration of Whitsleblower Policy

Sets forth what the policy and procedure is for reporting complaints about something the Board has done, in good faith, violate the antitrust law to the Board chair or officer of the Board. Protection for the person who made the complaint is provided.. Ms. McBride moved, which was seconded by Ms. Manale for provisional approval of the whitsleblower policy. The motion passed without opposition.
