C. Orleans Levee District (O.L.D.):

1. Motion to authorize the O.L.D. to accept a Louisiana Wildlife and Fisheries (LW&F) Foundation check in the amount of \$21,484.80 of which \$4,027.06 is reimbursement for a WL&F related change order for the Bayou St. John Obsolete Water Control Structure Removal Project, and the remaining \$17,457.74 is to be used for the Bayou St. John Dredging Project, and to increase the construction budget for the Water Control Structure Removal Project to \$100,000 with SLIP FY 2013 funds.

D. Lake Borgne Basin Levee District (LBBLD):

- 4. Motion to authorize the execution of a FHWA LA Rec Trails Application for a proposed bike path along the top of the Mississippi River Levee in St. Bernard Parish.
