SPECIAL REQUESTS

- **Cabot Corporation (Contract #20200327-ITE):**

Cabot Corporation is requesting to amend Sections 4.02(D) and 6.01(B)(1) of their existing Exhibit A agreement for Contract #20200327-ITE by an additional year, in order to extend the grace period to become fully operational.

From the Company: *“Cabot Corporation, Louisiana entered the above referenced Industrial Tax Exemption Contract with the State of Louisiana, effective February 22, 2021. Back then, who could have anticipated the worldwide COVID-19 pandemic, global supply chain issues, material and labor shortages, and other difficulties that would soon follow in the coming months and years; and would continue, to some extent, even today. Certainly, we did not.*

As such, we have already passed our original planned Commencement of Operations date of June 30, 2023 (Exhibit A Agreement Section 4.02(A)) and are approaching the end of the 2-year additional grace period provided in this Agreement (Section 6.01(B)(1)) to have commenced Operations, namely, June 30, 2025. We do not foresee becoming fully operational by this milestone.

Therefore, please accept this letter as Cabot Corporation’s formal request to amend Exhibit A Agreement Sections 4.02(D) and 6.01(B)(1), to read “three” instead of “two” years, effectively extending the commencement of operations and the grace period to be fully operational by one year, adjusting our Project Years, accordingly.

Rest assured that Cabot Corporation has proceeded “with commercially reasonable due diligence” on this Project, and we are anticipating the completion of this protracted endeavor. Given this extension, Cabot Corporation fully expects to meet, or exceed, the Project Estimated Investment Valuation (\$109,731,690), New Net Jobs Creation (15), Required Annual Payroll (\$1,095,000) contemplated in this Agreement.”
