Local Political Subdivisions - Loans

L20-094 - Ascension Parish, Housing Authority of the City of Donaldsonville

(1) Not exceeding \$1,500,000 construction loan, not exceeding 4%, mature no later than May 1, 2021, construction of 12 units of public housing; (2) Not exceeding \$1,500,000 permanent loan, non-interest bearing, not exceeding 5 years, pay-down of construction loan.

5. L19-280 - Terrebonne Parish, Coteau Fire Protection District

Not exceeding \$725,000 Certificate of Indebtedness, not exceeding 3.37%, mature no later than April 3, 2026, financing a new multipurpose training and administration facility and paying costs of issuance.

Local Political Subdivisions - Bonds - Final Approval

6. L20-109 - Caddo-Bossier Parishes Port Commission

Not exceeding \$2,800,000 Water Revenue Refunding Bonds, in one or more series, not exceeding 5%, mature no later than March 1, 2044, (1) refunding Water Revenue Bonds, Series 2003, (2) funding a debt service reserve fund, or purchasing a debt service reserve fund surety, if necessary and (3) purchasing a municipal bond insurance policy.

7. L20-112 - Caddo-Bossier Parishes Port Commission

Not exceeding \$5,250,000 Tax Revenue Bonds, in one or more series, not exceeding 4%, mature no later than March 1, 2030, **(1)** site acquisition, **(2)** construct, acquire, improve and/or equip facilities and **(3)** purchasing a bond insurance policy, if necessary.

8. L19-319 - Caddo Parish, Town of Blanchard (LDH Program)

Not exceeding \$3,700,000 Utilities System Revenue Bonds, in one or more series, not exceeding 3%, not exceeding 22 years, acquisition, construction and installation of improvements, extensions and replacements to the water system, including the physical consolidation of the Bel-Di-Gil Water System into the water system.

9. L20-110 - Caddo Parish, Town of Vivian

Not exceeding \$3,250,000 Water and Sewer System Revenue Refunding Bonds, in one or more series, not exceeding 5%, mature no later than April 1, 2049, (1) refunding Water and Sewer System Revenue Bonds, Series 2009, (2) funding a debt service reserve fund or paying the cost of a debt service reserve policy, if necessary and (3) paying the cost of bond insurance.

10. L20-111 - Livingston Parish School Board, School District No. 22

Not exceeding \$20,000,000 Taxable General Obligation School Refunding Bonds, in one or more series, not exceeding 5%, mature no later than March 1, 2031, refunding all or a portion of General Obligation School Bonds, Series 2010A and 2011.

11. L20-107 - Sabine Parish, Waterworks District No. 1 (LDH Program)

Not exceeding \$2,295,000 Taxable Excess Revenue Bonds, Series 2020, non-interest bearing, not exceeding 10 years, acquiring, constructing and installing improvements, extensions and additions to the drinking water system, including the acquisition and consolidation of the Ajax-Beulah Water Association into the District's water system

12. L20-106 - Tangipahoa Parish, Sewerage District No.1

Not exceeding \$5,650,000 Revenue Bonds, not exceeding 6%, not exceeding 30 years, (1) acquiring, constructing, extending and improving the sewerage system and (2) funding a debt service reserve fund, if necessary.

State Agencies, Boards and Commissions

13. S20-009 - Louisiana Housing Corporation (Lafayette Bottle Art Lofts Project)

Not exceeding \$8,100,000 Multifamily Housing Revenue Bonds (Volume Cap), in one or more series, not exceeding 12%, not exceeding 40 years, acquisition, construction, rehabilitation and equipping of a 40-unit multifamily housing facility in Lafayette.

14. S20-010 - Louisiana Housing Corporation (Villas of Lafayette Project)

Not exceeding \$5,500,000 Multifamily Housing Revenue Bonds (Volume Cap), in one or more series, not exceeding 12%, not exceeding 40 years, acquisition, construction and equipping of a 51-unit multifamily housing facility for seniors in Lafayette.

15. S20-011 - Louisiana Housing Corporation

Not exceeding \$19,000,000 Single Family Mortgage Revenue Refunding Bonds, in one or more series or sub-series, not exceeding 10%, not exceeding 32 years, refunding all or a portion of Single Family Mortgage Revenue Bonds, Series 2010A.

Political Subdivisions - Bonds

16. S20-012 - Louisiana Community Development Authority (University of Louisiana Monroe Facilities, Inc. - Student Hub Project)

Not exceeding \$8,000,000 Revenue Bonds, in one or more series, taxable or tax-exempt, not exceeding 5% fixed or variable rate, not exceeding 20 years, (1) development, design, construction and equipping of a student hub and related facilities, including equipment, furnishings, fixtures, facilities and infrastructure incidental or necessary in connection therewith, (2) funding a deposit to a debt service reserve fund, if necessary and (3) funding capitalized interest, if necessary.

Public Trust - Final Approval

17. S20-008 - Opelousas General Hospital Authority

Retroactive approval of not exceeding \$1,700,100 Promissory Note, not exceeding 3%, mature no later than August 1, 2021, purchase a DaVinci Xi System and all related necessary accessories.

18. S12-006B - Louisiana Public Facilities Authority (Lafayette General Medical Center Project)

Amendment of prior approvals granted on March 15, 2012 and July 19, 2012, to reflect change in cost of issuance and professionals associated with an interest rate conversion.

S15-058B - Louisiana Community Development Authority (Capital Area YMCA Projects)

Amendment of prior approvals granted on November 19, 2015, and December 17, 2015, to reflect change in cost of issuance associated with changes in terms, including an extension of maturity.

Amendment of a prior approval granted on November 15, 2018, to reflect change in location of project.

- 2. Select "Continue in Browser".
 - Note: Depending on the configuration of your device, a Plugin may need to be downloaded.
- 3. In "Welcome to Global Meet" screen, enter Email Address and select "Continue".
- 4. In next screen, complete "First Name" and "Last Name" fields, then select "Continue".
- 5. In "How would you like to talk in the meeting?" screen, select applicable option: "Use My Computer" or "Use My Phone".
 - Note: If you do not have a speaker/mic on your device, "Use My Phone" option should be selected.

CERTIFICATION OF INABILITY TO OPERATE DUE TO LACK OF QUORUM

In accordance with Executive Proclamations JBE 2020-30 and 2020-33, issued by Governor John Bel Edwards on March 16, 2020 and March 22, 2020, respectively, this notice shall serve as a certification of the Louisiana State Bond Commission's inability to otherwise operate in accordance with the Louisiana Open Meetings Law due to a lack of a quorum as a result of the COVID-19 public health emergency.

Pursuant to Section 4 of JBE 2020-30, the Louisiana State Bond Commission will provide for attendance at its essential government meeting on March 31, 2020, via video conference because it is unable to obtain a quorum (8 of 14 members). In addition, under Section 2 of JBE 2020-33, Governor Edwards ordered all public gatherings of ten (10) or more people to be suspended or postponed. The Louisiana State Bond Commission is composed of fourteen (14) members. It is essential for the Louisiana State Bond Commission to continue to operate because it must approve the issuance of any bonds, or other obligations, of the state and any political subdivision of the state under La. Const. art. VII, §8(B).

Considering the foregoing, and in accordance with Proclamation Numbers JBE 2020-30 and JBE 2020-33, the Louisiana State Bond Commission's meeting on Tuesday, March 31, 2020, at 8:00 a.m. will be held via video conference and in a manner that allows for observation and input by members of the public, as set forth in the Notice posted on March 26, 2020.
