After lengthy discussion and input from district defenders and program directors, the Budget Committee is recommending that staff be instructed to request a Declaration of Emergency from the Supreme Court Chief Justice and provide that letter to the Commissioner of Administration.
ii. Director of Training*

The Budget Committee requested that the full Board address the issue of the filling of the Director of Training position with in-house staff assuming those duties while continuing duties of current position.
b. Final FY18 CINC Disbursement*

OPB has advised staff to not disperse the balance of the CINC funds because of potential cuts to the agency. After discussions, the Budget Committee is recommending disbursement of the full balance, pro rata, in the total amount of $\$ 490,340$.

The Budget Committee is recommending that staff, Budget Committee Chairman North and the PDAL work to develop a new formula to distribute funds to the districts. Additionally, the Committee is recommending that staff be approved to accept grant funds to hire an econometrics group to assist in the DAF development. The Budget Committee is recommending a deadline of January 9, 2018 to present the new formula.
