- 7. **Policy** Tab 3
 - a. Sexual Harassment Policy*

ACT 270 which addresses sexual harassment prevention, policy and training requirements and mandatory yearly reporting was passed in the 2018 regular legislative session. Data collection will be required by all state agencies

beginning January 2019 and mandatory yearly reporting will be required beginning February, 2020. The Policy Committee will need to address the different levels of compliance for which the Board is/may be responsible.

b. Public Defenders Servings as City Prosecutors* pgs. 668-674

In December of 2010, the prior Board adopted the policy that all paid employees and independent contractors of a District Defender's Office, including, but not limited to the District Defender, are prohibited from serving as prosecutors in any court within the judicial district(s) in which they perform public defender services. Limited exception has been granted to the 8th, 30th and 15th Judicial District Public Defender Offices. At the September 27th meeting, the Board asked the Policy Committee to revisit this issue.

¹ The Board may vote to go into executive session pursuant to La. R.S. 42:16 and 42:17 (formerly La. R.S. 42:6 and 42:6.1), by a two-thirds vote of the members present. The executive session is limited to matters allowed to be exempted from public discussion pursuant to La. R.S. 42:17, including strategy sessions with respect to litigation and prospective litigation after formal demand. In accordance with La. R.S. 42:19(A)(b)(iii), the Board may discuss the following: Joseph Allen et al v. John Bel Edwards, et al, Docket: C655079, Section 27, 19th JDC, Parish of East Baton Rouge.
