Notice is hereby given to the public that the Louisiana Public Defender Board will meet at **12:00 p.m. on Thursday, October 8, 2020**, via video-conferencing pursuant to La. R. S. 42:17.1 (Act 302 of the 2020 Regular Session).

Certification

Pursuant to Proclamation Number JBE 2020-30, Governor John Bel Edwards, having declared COVID-19 to be a Public Health Emergency throughout the state of Louisiana, authorized boards and commissions and others to provide for attendance at public meetings via teleconference or video conference during the pendency of this emergency. As of July 24, 2020, this provision has expired and the legal framework of R.S. 42:17.1 (Act 302 of the 2020 Regular Session) is now operative law providing a public body to conduct a public meeting via electronic means pursuant to certification of the presiding officer. Therefore,

- I, C. Frank Holthaus, Chairman of the Louisiana Public Defender Board, hereby certify:
 - 1. That the agenda for the October 8, 2020 meeting is limited to one or more of the following:
 - a) Matters that are directly related to the LPDB response to the emergency and are critical to the health, safety, or welfare of the public;
 - b) Matters that if delayed will cause curtailment of vital public services or severe economic dislocation and hardship;
 - c) Matters that are critical to continuation of the business of the Louisiana Public Defender Board and cannot be postponed due to a legal requirement or other deadline that cannot be postponed or delayed.
 - 2. The nature of the COVID-19 Public Health Emergency continues to make an open meeting detrimental to the health, safety, or welfare of the public;
 - 3. That pursuant to La. R.S. 42:171 attendance shall be provided for and allowed via teleconference or video conference;
 - 4. That all efforts shall be made to provide for observation and input by the public; and
 - 5. That this certification shall be posted at the same time and in the same manner as the notice of meeting and agenda.
