Meeting Notes

Welcome/Meeting Objectives/Roll Call/Approval of Minutes

Lisa T. French, Executive Director, Career and Technical Education, Office of Student Opportunities, LDOE

Lisa French, commission co-chair, welcomed attendees and guests and requested that the roll be called. Megan Gravois moved and Sadie Phelps seconded the approval of the minutes as presented. Motion approved.

Overview of Commission Accomplishments:

Ms. French reviewed accomplishments of the Commission, highlighting the approval by Workforce Investment Council of the Louisiana Agritechnology Credential as a statewide Industry-Based Credential, the development and implementation of the agriculture based Career Readiness course, and the development and approval of the Agritechnology Pathway as a Jump Start Integrated Pathway.

USDA Agriculture's Team Nutrition Training Grant

Stephen Guccione and Emily Pineda, Division of Healthy Communities, LDOE

Mr. Guccione and Ms. Pineda shared information about the Nutrition grant emphasizing that the grant focus is on healthy eating and physical activity. Embedded in the grant is support for professional development and technical assistance. Five (5) entities have applied for the fifteen (15) multi-year grants. FFA Update

Dr. Eric Smith, State FFA Executive Director of Agriculture Education

Dr. Smith shared video from Farm Bureau Television providing an overview of agriculture in Louisiana. Together, Louisiana State University's College of Agriculture and Louisiana FFA's data analysis indicates that there are agriculture programs in 57/68 school districts, programs span from rural to urban, and show that approximately 70% of the participants are males and 30% are females; however, that percentage gap narrows for educators.

Multiple associations support agriculture efforts including the Louisiana Forestry Association, represented by Mr. Buck Vandersteen. These associations support Louisiana FFA's Career Development Events and provide scholarships to both two-year and four-year colleges.

Goal of FFA is to expand opportunities for students in agriculture by increasing awareness about the Agritechnology Industry-Based Certification (IBC) and promoting interest in developing Forestry IBC.

2017 - 2018 Commission Focus/Priorities and Timelines

1) Expand awareness and support of Agritechnology IBC: Thirteen (13) agriscience teachers earned this credential this fall. Sessions to review and take the assessment will be offered at FFA meetings and LATA convention during summer 2018.

- 2) Update CTE Bulletin 106: Sadie Phelps and Marcy Mahler are leading review of Bulletin 106 and will work, this summer, with Task Force to cross-reference current bulletin with national standards and Agriscience I, II, and II guidelines. Next steps include a conference call to define additional support and establish plan of action and timeline.
- 3) Develop new agriculture IBC: Team is investigating adding Forestry and looking at other Career Development Events for possibilities.
