2	To amend and reenact the heading of Chapter 27-E of Title 33 of the Louisiana Revised
3	Statutes of 1950 and R.S. 33:9039.61, 9039.62, 9039.65(3), 9039.66(A)(1) and (J),
4	and 9039.68(B)(1) and (2), relative to the Greater New Orleans Biosciences
5	Economic Development District; to change the name of the Greater New Orleans
6	Biosciences Economic Development District to the BioDistrict New Orleans; to
7	provide for definitions; to change the composition of the board of commissioners and
8	the advisory committee for the BioDistrict New Orleans; to modify certain
9	subdistrict designations; and to provide for related matters.
10	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
11	Section 1. The heading of Chapter 27-E of Title 33 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes
12	of 1950 and R.S. 33:9039.61, 9039.62, 9039.65(3), 9039.66(A)(1) and (J), and
13	9039.68(B)(1) and (2) are hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:
14	CHAPTER 27-E. GREATER NEW ORLEANS BIOSCIENCES
15	ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT ACT
16	BIODISTRICT NEW ORLEANS ACT
17	§9039.61. The Greater New Orleans Biosciences Economic Development District
18	Act BioDistrict New Orleans Act
19	This Chapter shall be known as the "The Greater New Orleans Biosciences
20	Economic Development District Act "BioDistrict New Orleans Act".

1	§9039.62. Greater New Orleans Biosciences Economic Development District
2	BioDistrict New Orleans; creation; territorial jurisdiction
3	There is hereby created the Greater New Orleans Biosciences Economic
4	Development District BioDistrict New Orleans, referred to in this Chapter as the
5	"district". The district shall be composed of all of the territory located in the parish
6	of Orleans bounded by Earhart Blvd., Carrollton Ave., Loyola Ave., and Iberville St.
7	The district shall be a political subdivision of the state as defined in Article VI,
8	Section 44(2) of the Constitution of Louisiana. Pursuant to Article VI, Sections 19
9	and 20 of the Constitution of Louisiana, the district, acting through its board of
10	commissioners, the governing authority of the district, is hereby granted all of the
11	rights, powers, privileges, and immunities accorded by law and the Constitution of
12	Louisiana to political subdivisions of the state, including but not limited to the power
13	to incur debt.

15	§9039.65. Definitions
16	The following words or terms as used in this Chapter shall have the following
17	meaning:

19	(3) "District" means the Greater New Orleans Biosciences Economic
20	Development District BioDistrict New Orleans as further defined in R.S. 33:9039.62.

22	§9039.66. Board of commissioners; members; officers; advisory committee
23	A.(1) The district shall be governed by a board of commissioners referred
24	to in this Chapter as the "board" consisting of thirteen fifteen members comprised
25	of the following:
26	(a) The president of the Louisiana State University System or his designee.
27	(b) The president of Tulane University or the president's designee.
28	(c) The president of Xavier University or the president's designee.

1	(d) The chancellor of Delgado Community College or the chancellor's
2	designee.
3	(e) The mayor of the city of New Orleans or the mayor's designee.
4	(f) Three appointments by the mayor of the city of New Orleans from
5	nominees submitted by Greater New Orleans, Inc., the New Orleans Chamber of
6	Commerce, and the New Orleans Business Council.
7	(g) Four appointed by the governor, at least two of which shall be residents
8	of Orleans Parish.
9	(h) The secretary of the Department of Economic Development or the
10	secretary's designee.
11	(i) Two members who reside within the boundaries of the BioDistrict New
12	Orleans, to be appointed by the representatives and senators for the districts that
13	overlap the boundaries of the BioDistrict New Orleans.

15	J. There shall be an advisory committee of the district created by the board
16	of commissioners of the district, which may include but not be limited to
17	representatives of the Ochsner Foundation, the New Orleans Foundation, Children's
18	Hospital, Department of Veteran's Affairs Medical Center, the University of New
19	Orleans, the Greater New Orleans Foundation, Black Economic Development
20	Council, the New Orleans Downtown Development District, Dillard University, and
21	Southern University of New Orleans, and two members appointed by the
22	representatives and senators for the districts that overlap the boundaries of the
23	BioDistrict New Orleans.

25	§9039.68. General powers
26	* * *
27	B.(1) At least ten days after publication of a notice in the official journal of
28	the district, a public hearing shall be conducted, and the board may then designate

1 one or more areas within or without the boundaries of the district as they may exist 2 from time to time as a separate subdistrict or as an enlargement of the original 3 district, provided that subdistricts created by the board outside the then current 4 boundaries of the district need not be contiguous to the district. Any territory outside 5 the original boundaries of the district which is sought to be included in the district 6 or designated as a separate subdistrict may only be so included or designated subject 7 to the approval of the governing board of the parish or municipality having 8 jurisdiction over such territory. Each subdistrict shall constitute a separate political 9 subdivision of the state, governed by the district board with the same powers of the 10 district. Each designated subdistrict area shall be representative of its geographic 11 location and designated as "Greater New Orleans Biosciences Economic Development Subdistrict No. \_\_\_\_BioDistrict Economic Development Subdistrict for 12 13 ".

(2) In addition to any other provision of this Chapter, the owner or owners 14 15 of land whether or not contiguous to the district may file with the board a petition 16 requesting that there be included as an enlargement of the original district or 17 designated as a separate subdistrict, the land described in the petition by metes and 18 bounds or by lot and block number if there is a recorded plat of the area to be 19 included in the district. The board shall hear and consider the petition and may add 20 the land described to the original district or designated as a subdistrict in the petition 21 if it is feasible, practicable, and to the advantage of the district. Upon receipt of such 22 petition and at least ten days after publication of a notice in the official journal of the 23 district, a public hearing shall be conducted, and the board shall consider the petition 24 and may then enlarge the boundaries of the district or designate one or more areas 25 within or without the boundaries of the district as they may exist from time to time 26 as a subdistrict if it is practicable, feasible, and to the benefit of the district to do so. 27 Subdistricts created outside the then current boundaries of the district also need not 28 be contiguous to the district. Any territory outside the district which is sought to be

1	included in the district or designated as a subdistrict, may only be so included subject
2	to the approval of the governing board of the parish or municipality having
3	jurisdiction over such territory. Each subdistrict shall constitute a separate political

6	location and designated as "Greater New Orleans Biosciences Economic
