

**CHAPTER 19. GOVERNOR'S COUNCIL ON
PHYSICAL FITNESS AND SPORTS**

§ 2451. Creation; membership; term of office

- A. An agency of the state to be known as the Governor's Council on Physical Fitness and Sports is hereby created and established in the Department of Health and Human Resources, hereinafter in this Chapter referred to as the department. The council shall exercise the powers and duties hereinafter set forth or otherwise provided by law.
- B. The council shall consist of fifteen members who shall be appointed by the governor and shall be representative of physicians, pediatricians, coaches, physical therapists, athletic trainers, athletes, educators and such other persons or professions interested in the physical fitness of the citizens of Louisiana. In making his appointments, the governor shall also take into consideration the various geographic areas of the state with a view to giving all sections of the state representation on the council.
- C. The terms of office of members of the council shall be for three years expiring on September 1 in the appropriate year. Of the initial members appointed to the board, four members shall be appointed for terms of one year, five members shall be appointed for terms of two years, and six members shall be appointed for terms of three years, as determined by the governor. The governor may reappoint any person who has served or is serving as a member of the council. A vacancy shall be filled by appointment only for the remainder of the unexpired term. Each appointment by the governor shall be submitted to the Senate for confirmation, and beginning in 1984 every appointment confirmed by the Senate shall again be submitted by the governor to the Senate for confirmation every two years after the initial confirmation.
- D. The council shall meet and organize immediately after appointment of the members and shall elect from its membership a chairman and a vice chairman. The council shall adopt rules for the transaction of its business and shall keep a record of its resolutions, transactions, findings, and determinations. Eight members shall constitute a quorum.
- E. The council shall meet at least once in each quarter of the fiscal year, and as often thereafter as shall be deemed necessary by the chairman.
- F. By a two-thirds vote of the council, a member may be dismissed from membership for such reasons as the council may establish, which reasons
