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# **LABOR & MATERIALS TO REPLACE ONE (1) CHAIN LINK FENCE AT M.L. KING PLAYGROUND**

## **SECTION 1.0 – SITE VISITS**

## **SECTION 2.0 – SCOPE:**

We extend this bid to cover all labor, materials, and necessary essentials to remove and replace a one hundred and fifty (150) feet long x thirty (30) feet high section of chain link fencing and attached poles at the above location. Remove one hundred and fifty (150) feet of existing exterior six (6) feet chain link fencing under the thirty (30) feet high fencing.

## **SECTION 3.0 –LICENSE REQUIREMENTS:**

The following Louisiana State license shall be required for this project:

- Commercial License - Louisiana State Specialty Licenses in Fencing.

## **SECTION 4.0 – BOND REQUIREMENTS**

- Bid Bond – 5% Electronic bond is required with bid submission.
- Performance Bond – 50% of the contract price and due at signing of contract.
- Payment Bond – 50 % of the contract price and due at signing of contract.

## **SECTION 5.0 – QUANTITIES/INSPECTION:**

Bidders must inspect the site and perform their own measurements in order to determine the proper quantity of materials and equipment required to complete this project. All measurements given in these specifications are informational only.

## **SECTION 6.0 – BID SPECIFICATIONS:**

The successful bidder shall supply all labor, materials and necessary essentials to perform the following at ML King Playground.

- Remove and replace a one hundred and fifty (150) feet long x thirty (30) feet high section of chain link fence and attached poles.
- Parks and Recreation will not be responsible for any materials or equipment on site while the job is in progress.
- Awarded vendor must provide their own dumpster on site to dispose of debris and must get dumpster location approved.
- Vendor shall be responsible for furnishing and installing all equipment, parts, supplies, supervision and personnel needed, plus any permits, fees, etc. needed to complete this job.
- Fabric: 120" 9-gauge 2.0 oz (2" mesh) KT Chain Link Fence.
- Top Rail: 1 5/8" O.D. Schedule 40 Pipe, 2.27 lbs. per foot. Top rail to be 21 feet in length joined with 1 5/8" galvanized sleeve.
- Line Post: 3" Schedule 40 Pipe, 5.79 lbs. per foot. Line post 10' on center spacing. Each to have concrete footings measuring 24" in diameter and at a 50" depth.
- Terminal Post: 4" O.D. Schedule 40 Pipe, 9.11 lbs. per foot. Each to have concrete footings measuring 24" in diameter, and at a 50" depth.
- Bracing: 1 5/8" O.D. Schedule 40 Pipe, 2.27lbs. per foot, used for both middle rail and top rail.
- Fittings: Beveled brace band and galvanized with nut carriage bolt, pressed steel combo rail-end, 14-gauge steel boulevard clamp, pressed steel loop cap, 3/4" steel tension bar, beveled tension band and galvanized with nut carriage bolt.
- Tie Wire: 9 ½ 9-gauge aluminum tie wire and 8 ¼" 9-gauge aluminum tie wire spaced 6" on center for line posts and 6" on center for rails.
- Concrete Footings: To be truck poured concrete.
- Remove one hundred and fifty (150) feet of existing six (6) feet exterior fencing under the thirty (30) feet high fencing.

## **SECTION 7.0 - HOURS OF WORK:**

Work shall be performed during normal working hours. All work must be scheduled with owner representative 5 days in advance. The successful bidder shall work normal building working hours (8:00am – 4:00pm) to provide a safe work environment at no extra charge to Jefferson Parish.

## **SECTION 8.0 – CLEANING AREA AND SAFETY:**

Job site must be clean and free of all litter and debris daily and upon completion of the contract. Passageways must be kept clean and free of material, equipment, and debris at all times. Inflammable material must be removed from the job site daily, because storage will not be permitted on the premises. Precautions must be exercised at all times to safeguard the welfare and safety of the general public, employees of Jefferson Parish, and other Parish officials.

## **SECTION 9.0 – EXISTING STRUCTURE**

Should any cutting, patching, alteration, addition, or repairs to existing structure or fence be required of this project, the successful bidder shall restore the alteration to its original condition, with the same type materials, finish, and workmanship.

## **SECTION 10.0 – WARRANTY:**

All workmanship shall be done not to interfere with the existing One (1) year warranty in writing, from the manufacturer from the date of acceptance of the projects against defects. The bidder must agree, upon written notice from the owner, promptly and without charge, and to the satisfaction of the owner, to make changes, replacements, and corrections which may be required to make good all defects in materials and/or equipment under its intended use, within the warranty period, at no cost to the owner.

## **SECTION 11.0 – SDS:**

The bidder shall notify the Jefferson Parish Department of Recreation contact person of any hazardous substances that will be brought to and/or used at the workplace. The bidder shall provide SDS as per this requirement to the Director of the Jefferson Parish Department of Recreation.

### **SECTION 12.0 – PERMITS:**

The successful bidder shall obtain any and all permits required by the Jefferson Parish Department of Inspection and Code Enforcement and/or the City of Gretna. The successful bidder shall also be responsible for payment of these permits. All permits must be obtained prior to the start of the project.

### **SECTION 13.0 – PRE-CONSTRUCTION CONFERENCE AND NOTICE TO PROCEED:**

A Pre-Construction Conference shall be held between the successful bidder and the owner before any work commences. No work shall be performed until the successful bidder receives a written “Notice to Proceed” to begin work, from the Department of Recreation.

### **SECTION 14.0 – CONSTRUCTION TERM:**

Upon receiving a notice to proceed, the Bidder agrees that all work shall be completed as follows: Vendor agrees to commence actual physical work on the site with an adequate force and equipment within 10 days from the date of Notice of Proceed. All work shall be substantially completed in **NINETY (90)** consecutive calendar days from date of Notice to Proceed.
