Sealed bids will be received until the hour of 11:00 A.M., local time, Wednesday, April 5, 2023, in the office of the Purchasing Agent, City Hall, Mandeville, Louisiana, 3101 East Causeway Approach, Mandeville, LA 70448; for furnishing all labor, materials, supervision, etc., and performing all work necessary to complete **HURRICANE IDA NRCS DRAINAGE CANAL CLEANING, PROJECT NO.: 211.23.006**; for the City of Mandeville. Bids will be opened and publicly read aloud after 11:00 A.M. in the City Council Chambers, City Hall, Mandeville, Louisiana. Any bids received after 11:00 A.M. will be returned unopened.

This Work consists of drainage canal cleaning throughout the City of Mandeville. The Work generally involves the removal and disposal of fallen trees, fallen vegetation, rubbish, and debris deposited into 16 drainage canals by Hurricane Ida in various locations across the City of Mandeville.
