PUBLIC WORKS BID INSTRUCTIONS

A. LOUISIANA CONTRACTOR'S LICENSE FOR THIS PROJECT

Must be in the following category:

Highway, Street, and Bridge Construction

Each bidder shall comply with all rules and regulations of the Louisiana State Licensing Board for Contractors in accordance with existing state laws, and shall comply with the Licensing Requirements of Jefferson Parish Ordinance No. 13574, as amended a copy of which may be obtained from the Office of the Parish Clerk, Suite 6700, Jefferson Parish General Government Building, 200 Derbigny Street, Gretna, Louisiana 70053.

The purpose and intention of this invitation to bid is to afford all suppliers/contractors an equal opportunity to bid on construction, maintenance, repair, operating, services, supplies and/or equipment listed in this bid proposal. Jefferson Parish will accept one bid only from each vendor. Items bid on must meet or exceed specifications. Where brand names, make, manufacturer or stock numbers are specified, it is for the purpose of establishing certain minimum standards of quality. Bidders may submit for products of equal quality, style, type and character, provided brand names and stock numbers are specified. Complete product data may be required prior to award.

The price quoted for the work shall be stated in figures. In the event there is a difference in unit prices and totals, the unit prices shall prevail. In the event there is a difference in unit prices, written unit prices shall prevail over numerical unit prices.

The quantities listed on the bid form are prepared for comparison of bids and may be approximate. Payment to the contractor will be made in accordance with measurement and payment requirements for bid items and other requirements of the project specifications. Bid item quantities may be increased, decreased, or omitted as provided in the specifications.

Jefferson Parish requires all products to be new (current), and all work must be performed according to standard practices for the project. Unless otherwise specified, no after market parts will be accepted. Unless otherwise specified, all workmanship and materials must have at least a one (1) year guaranty, in writing, from the date of delivery/acceptance of the project.

C. METHODS OF BID SUBMISSION

All bids shall be submitted electronically through Jefferson Parish's eProcurement System online at no charge via Jefferson Parish's electronic procurement page by visiting <u>www.jeffparishbids.net</u>. Registration and use of this site are free to Jefferson Parish vendors. Additional instructions are included in the text box highlighting electronic procurement.

Only bids properly signed (see more below) will be accepted. NO LATE BIDS WILL BE ACCEPTED. The name of the bidder must be legibly shown. If the bidder is an individual, their name and address should be shown. If the bidder is an entity, the name of the person given the requisite authority to submit the bid on behalf of the entity shall be shown and the address of the entity's place of business should be shown.

Evidence of agency, corporate, limited liability or partnership authority of the person submitting and signing the bid is required for submission of bid. A copy of a corporate resolution or other signature authorization shall be required for submission of the bid. Failure to include a copy of the appropriate signature authorization will result in the rejection of the bid unless bidder has complied with LSA-R.S. 38:2212(B)(5). Photostatic or font signatures shall result in the bid being rejected. However, an electronic signature as defined in LSA-R.S. 9:2602(8) is acceptable. Signature must be a secured digital signature. A sample corporate resolution and sample certification of sole proprietorship can downloaded from the Jefferson Parish Purchasing Department's website be http://purchasing.jeffparish.net, or you may provide your own document.

D. TIMELINES

1. Prior to the closing time for receipt of scheduled bids

A bid may be withdrawn at any time prior to the scheduled closing time for receipt of bids, provided a request in writing, executed by the bidder or his duly authorized representative, is filed with the Parish prior to that time. When such a request is received, the bid will be returned to the bidder unopened. However, no bid can be modified, corrected or withdrawn after the time set for closing such bid, except as provided by LSA-R.S. 38:2214(C) & (D).

The Parish, its engineers, architects or anyone distributing plans and specifications for Parish public work projects, equal to or over the contract limit as defined in LA-R.S. 38:2212, shall furnish all prime bidders who request bid documents and who are properly licensed by the Louisiana State Licensing Board for Contractors with at least one set of complete bid documents. A deposit or fee may be charged on the documents as authorized by LA-R.S. 38:2212.

Addenda may be issued, as authorized by LA-R.S. 38:2212 (O). All formal Addenda require written acknowledgment on the bid form by the bidder. Failure to acknowledge an Addendum on the bid form shall cause the bid to be rejected. Jefferson Parish reserves the right to award the bid to the next lowest responsive and responsible bidder in this event.

Prior to submitting a bid each bidder shall visit the site of the proposed work and fully acquaint himself with all surface and subsurface conditions as they may exist so that he may fully understand the facilities, difficulties, and restrictions attending the execution of the work under this Contract. Bidders shall also thoroughly examine and be familiar with Drawings, Specifications, and Contract Documents. The failure or omission of any bidder to receive or examine any form, instrument, drawing, or document or to visit the site and acquaint himself with conditions there existing, shall in no way relieve any bidder from any obligation with respect to

his bid and the responsibility in the premises rests with him. Submission of a bid shall be considered prima facie evidence that the bidder has made such examination and is satisfied as to the conditions to be encountered in performing the work and as to requirements of the plans, project specifications, Resolution No. 141125, as amended, and contract forms.

Any pre-bid test and boring data in connection with subsurface conditions which have been completed by the Parish or its engineers and furnished to the bidder shall not be considered as fully representative of subsurface conditions existing throughout the area tested nor shall they in any way be binding upon the Parish, it being understood that said data is furnished the bidder for his convenience only and the bidder shall be solely responsible for conducting his own boring explorations he deems necessary in preparing his bid. Any prospective bidder wishing to conduct boring explorations on Parish property must obtain written permission from Jefferson Parish prior to such explorations.

No claims shall be made against the Parish for additional compensation due to unforeseen subsurface conditions arising during progress of the work and which might be in variance with the Parish's pre-bid boring data.

2. Post-closing time for receipt of scheduled bids

Except as where provided by law, bidder agrees that this bid shall be legally binding and may not be withdrawn for a period of forty-five (45) calendar days after the scheduled closing time for receiving bids. In the event the Parish issues the Letter of Award (copy of adopted resolution awarding bid by Jefferson Parish Council) during this period, the bid accepted shall continue to remain binding pending execution of the Contract.

Bidder agrees to execute the ensuing Contract and will deliver applicable Bonds to secure the faithful performance thereof.

The Parish of Jefferson reserves the right to cancel this contract for convenience by issuing a thirty (30) day written notice to contractor.

E. BID REVIEW AND AWARD

1. Rejection of Bids

- a. Jefferson Parish may reject any and all bids for just cause in accordance with LA R.S. 38:2214(B). Just cause, for the purpose of the construction of public works, is defined, but is not limited to, the following circumstances:
 - (1) The public entity's unavailability of funds sufficient for the construction of the proposed public work.
 - (2) The failure of any bidder to submit a bid within an established threshold of the preconstruction estimates for that public work, as part of the bid specifications.
 - (3) A substantial change by the public entity prior to the award in the scope or design of the proposed public work.
 - (4) A determination by the public entity not to build the proposed public work within twelve months of the date for the public opening and reading of bids.
 - (5) The disqualification by the public entity of all bidders.

- b. Additionally, bids may be considered irregular and be rejected for any of the following, but is not limited to the following circumstances:
 - (1) If the bid form is on a form other than that furnished by the Parish or if the form is altered or any part thereof is detached.
 - (2) If affidavits included in bid form and/or required by law are not returned with the bid or are not properly executed and notarized.
 - (3) If there are unauthorized additions, conditional or alternate bids or irregularities which alter the general terms and conditions, the plans or specifications, or make the bid incomplete, indefinite, or ambiguous as to its meaning.
 - (4) If the bidder adds provisions reserving the right to accept or reject the award or to enter into the contract pursuant to the award.
 - (5) If an owner or a principal officer of the bidding firm is an owner or a principal officer of a firm which has been declared by the Parish to be ineligible to bid.
 - (6) If the proposed bid security does not meet the requirements of Section J.
 - (7) If more than one proposal for the same work, services, materials or supplies is received from an individual, partner, firm, corporation, joint venture, other legal entity, or combination thereof under the same or a different name.
 - (8) The bid is not properly signed or the authority of the signature person submitting the bid is deemed insufficient or unacceptable.
 - (9) If the bidder does not possess the proper license(s) required as noted in the specifications.
 - (10) Any other reasons for rejection set forth by State or Parish laws, Ordinances or Resolutions.
- c. In awarding contracts for materials and supplies, Jefferson Parish shall reject the lowest bid if received from a bidder domiciled in a Communist country, or if the materials or supplies are manufactured in a Communist country, including but not limited to China, North Korea and Vietnam, and to award the contract to the next lowest bidder. This Section shall not apply to any country having established trade relations agreements or approvals from the government of the United States. (LSA-R.S. 38:2212.3)

2. Disqualification of Bids

- a. The causes for disqualification from consideration for award of a contract with Jefferson Parish are as follows (Jefferson Parish Code of Ordinances, Section 2-912):
 - (1) Conviction for commission of a criminal offense as an incident to obtaining or attempting to obtain a public or private contract or subcontract, or in the performance of such contract or subcontract;
 - (2) Conviction under state or federal statutes of embezzlement, theft, forgery, bribery, falsification or destruction of records, receiving stolen property, or any other offense indicating a lack of business integrity or business honesty which currently, seriously, and directly affects responsibility as a Parish contractor;
 - (3) Conviction under state or federal antitrust statutes arising out of the submission of bids or proposals;
 - (4) Violation of contract provisions, as set forth below, of a character which is regarded by the Purchasing Director or his designee for Jefferson Parish to be serious as to justify disqualification:
 - i. Deliberate failure without good cause to perform in accordance with the specifications or within the time limit provided in the contract; or

- ii. A recent record of failure to perform or of unsatisfactory performance in accordance with the terms of one or more contracts; provided that failure to perform or unsatisfactory performance caused by acts beyond the control of the contractor shall not be considered to be a basis for disqualification; or
- iii. Failure to timely pay, without cause, a subcontractor for work performed under a construction contract as required under Section 2-976 in Chapter 2, Article VII, of the Jefferson Parish Code of Ordinances, provided disqualification on such basis shall not exceed a period of one (1) year from the deadline to pay the subcontractor.
- (5) Any other cause the Purchasing Director determines to be so serious and compelling as to affect responsibility as a Parish contractor, including debarment by another governmental entity for any cause;
- (6) Violation of the State Code of Ethics or the ethical standards set forth in the Jefferson Parish Code of Ordinances;
- (7) Failure to secure and/or maintain necessary licenses and/or permits;
- (8) Failure to comply with the Jefferson Parish Code of Ordinances and/or the Jefferson Parish Comprehensive Zoning Ordinance; or failure to comply with or meet bid specifications and/or failure to be a responsible bidder.
- (9) A bid which is not responsive to, or does not meet bid specifications, will be rejected as being non-responsive, but that bidder will not be disqualified from future Parish bids, nor will that bidder be given a hearing pursuant to procedure listed below.
- b. The procedures for disqualification from consideration for award of a contract with Jefferson Parish are set forth in Sec. 2- 912 (b).

3. Award of Contract

The award of the contract, if it be awarded, will be by the Parish to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder whose proposal shall have complied with all the bid requirements. The successful bidder will be notified via the e-Procurement site that his bid has been accepted. No contract shall be executed with any contractor until their certificates of insurance, performance bonds, labor and materials payment bonds, or any other bonds required are made satisfactory to the Parish.

Jefferson Parish reserves the right to award contracts or place orders on a lump sum or individual item basis, or such combination as shall, in its judgment, be in the best interest of Jefferson Parish. Every contract or order shall be awarded to the lowest responsible bidder, taking into consideration the conformity with the specifications, and the delivery and/or completion date.

Preference will be given to bidders requesting a preference in their bid in accordance with LSA-R.S. 38:2251-2261 for materials, supplies, and provisions, produced, manufactured or grown in Louisiana, quality being equal to articles offered by competitors outside the State of Louisiana, unless federal funding is directly spent by Jefferson Parish on this project.

The successful bidder shall execute the contract with the Parish in the form of the contract included in the specifications, a copy of which is annexed hereto, in such number of counterparts as the Parish may request within twelve (12) days after receipt of notice of award of the contract by the Parish. One copy of the executed contract with all documents forming a part thereof shall be filed at the expense of the contractor, with the Recorder of Mortgages in Jefferson Parish.

PROTESTS: Only those vendors that submit bids in response to this solicitation may protest any element of the procurement, in writing to the Director of the Purchasing Department. Written protest must be received within 48 hours of the release of the bid tabulation by the Purchasing Department. After consultation, the Parish Attorney's Office will then respond to protests in writing. (For more information, please see Chapter 2, Article VII, Division 2, Sec. 2-913 of the Jefferson Parish Code of Ordinances.)

Upon full execution of the contract and receiving a written notice to proceed, the bidder agrees that all work shall be completed as follows:

The work shall be substantially complete within _____ calendar days of the written notice to proceed and completed and shall be ready for final acceptance no more than 30 calendar days after substantial completion.

F. SALES TAX EXEMPTION

For this project, the contractor shall not pay any state or local sales or use taxes on materials and equipment which are affixed and made part of the immovable property of the project or which is permanently incorporated in the project (hereinafter referred to as "applicable materials and equipment"). All purchases of applicable materials or equipment shall be made by the contractor on behalf of and as the agent of Jefferson Parish (Parish), a political subdivision of the State of Louisiana. No state and local sales and use taxes are owed on applicable materials and equipment under the provisions of Act 1029 of the 1991 Regular Session – Louisiana Revised Statute 47:301(8)(c). Parish will furnish to contractor a certificate form which certifies that Parish is not required to pay such state or local sales and use taxes, and contractor shall furnish a copy of such certificate to all vendors or suppliers of the applicable materials and equipment, and report to Parish the amount of taxes not incurred.

G. LIQUIDATED DAMAGES

In accordance with Resolution No. 141125, as amended, Bidder agrees to pay, as liquidated damages, the sum of \$_______ for: (1) each consecutive calendar day after the agreed date of substantial completion that the work remains substantially incomplete, and (2) each consecutive calendar day after the 30th day following the actual date of substantial completion that the work has not been finally completed.

In addition to, but not in lieu of the per diem liquidated damages, Parish shall also be entitled to recover from the contractor or the contractor's surety additional liquidated damages as detailed in Resolution No. 141125, as amended. These additional liquidated damages may include, but are not limited to the following, in the amounts and for each of the items identified in the Supplementary Conditions:

(1)	Extended Architectural and/or Engineering Fees	\$	/hour
(2)	Extended Resident Project Representative Fee	\$	/hour
(3)	Extended Construction Management Fees	\$	/day
(4)	Extended Parish's Overhead and Personnel Expenses	\$ <u> </u>	/hour

(5) Parish's Other Costs Directly Related to the Delay in Completion Beyond the Contract Times.

Whenever contractor's work requires inspections in excess of the budgeted amount for inspection, the contractor shall reimburse the Parish for the additional costs incurred by the Parish attributable to inspection of the contracted project in excess of the budgeted amount for inspections.

The reasonable budget for such inspections is \$______. Resident Project Representative overtime rates shall be calculated at 1.2 times the hourly rate. The cost of inspection in excess of this budgeted amount shall be assessed against Contractor's progress payments, all in accordance with Louisiana Public Bid Law.

H. ETHICAL STANDARDS AND COOPERATION WITH THE OFFICE OF THE INSPECTOR GENERAL, INCLUDING CONFLICTS OF INTEREST

Vendor agrees by bid submission to comply with all provisions of Louisiana Law as well as compliance with the Jefferson Parish Code of Ordinances, Louisiana Code of Ethics, as published on http://ethics.la.gov and applicable Jefferson Parish ethical standards and Jefferson Parish Terms and Conditions.

<u>Inspector General</u>: It shall be the duty of every Parish officer, employee, department, agency, special district, board, and commission; and the duty of every contractor, subcontractor, and licensee of the Parish, and the duty of every applicant for certification of eligibility for a Parish contract or program, to cooperate with the Inspector General in any investigation, audit, inspection, performance review, or hearing pursuant to JPCO 2-155.10(19). Every Parish contract and every bid, proposal, application or solicitation for a Parish contract, and every application for certification of eligibility for a Parish contract or program shall contain a statement that the corporation, partnership, or person understands and will abide by all provisions of JPCO 2-155.10. By submitting a bid, Bidder acknowledges this and will abide by all provisions of the referenced JPCO.

<u>Conflicts of Interest</u>: Jefferson Parish adheres to the Louisiana Code of Governmental Ethics, contained in Louisiana Revised Statutes Annotated, R.S. 42:1101, et seq. Vendor/Proposer by this submission warrants that there are no "conflicts of interest" related to this procurement that would violate applicable Louisiana Law. Violation of the Louisiana Code of Governmental Ethics may result in rescission of contract, permit or licenses, and the imposition of fines and/or penalties, without contractual liability to the public in accordance with applicable law.

I. REQUIRED AFFIDAVITS

For convenience, all legally mandated affidavits have been combined into one form, entitled **Public Works Bid Affidavit**. All bidders must submit with their bid submission, a completed, signed and properly notarized affidavit in its original format and without alteration in order to be compliant and for the bid to be considered responsive. A scanned copy of the completed, signed and properly notarized affidavit may be submitted with the bid; however, the successful bidder must submit the original affidavit in its original format and without material alteration prior to, or at contract execution. Failure to comply will result in the bid submission being rejected as non-responsive. The Parish reserves the right to award bid to the next lowest responsive and responsible bidder in this event. The person submitting the bid, and whose authority to submit has been evidenced on the Corporate Resolution is the proper party to execute the **Public Works Bid Affidavit**.

J. BID REQUIREMENTS (BID DOCUMENTS, SPECIFICATIONS, BONDS, W-9 AND PAYMENT INFO)

Bidders must review the bid specifications and include any required documentation including but not limited to the LA Public Works Uniform Bid Form, Bid Security, Corporate Resolution or written evidence of signature authority, and the Public Works Affidavit. Pursuant to LA R.S. 38:2212(B)(3)(b), bidders shall also be responsible for providing any other documentation as required. Please note that the payment and performance bonds must be supplied by the successful bidder at contract signing.

No oral interpretation will be made to any bidder as to the meaning of the drawings, specifications, or contract documents. Every request for such interpretation shall be made in writing and addressed and forwarded to the Engineer, Architect or person distributing plans and specifications. No inquiry received within five (5) days prior to the day fixed for opening of the bids will be given consideration. Every interpretation made to the bidder shall be in the form of an addendum to the specifications and shall be issued as authorized by LA-R.S. 38:2212(O).

All such addenda shall become a part of the contract documents. Failure of any bidder to receive any such interpretation shall not relieve any bidder from any obligation under his bid as submitted without modification.

The specifications and plans are complementary of each other and all work called for or reasonably implied by either shall be performed as if called for by both. In case of conflict between the requirements of the specifications and plans, the specifications shall take precedence. Figured dimensions shall take precedence over scale dimensions, and larger scale details shall take precedence over smaller scale details in the general work drawings.

All vendors submitting bids shall register as a Jefferson Parish vendor, if not already registered. Registration forms may be downloaded from <u>http://purchasing.jeffparish.net</u> and click on Vendor Information. Current W-9 forms with respective Tax Identification numbers and vendor applications may be submitted at any time; however, if your company is not registered and/or a current W-9 form is not on file, vendor registration is mandatory. Vendors may experience a delay in payment if your company is not a registered vendor with Jefferson Parish.

Bidders must comply with all provisions of this Notice, the Standard General Conditions of the Construction Contract and any special conditions and specifications contained herein, all of which are made part of this bid proposal. Resolution No. 141125, as amended, will be considered a part of the bid whether attached or not. A copy of these terms and resolutions may be obtained from the Office of the Parish Clerk, Suite 6700, Jefferson Parish General Government Building, 200 Derbigny Street, Gretna, Louisiana 70053. Bidders may also obtain a copy by visiting the Purchasing Department's webpage at http://purchasing.jeffparish.net and clicking on online forms.

Bid Security: Bidders shall provide bid security in the form of an electronic bid bond in the amount of five percent (5%) of the total bid price (Base Bid and any Alternates) (as per R.S. 38:2218). The Bid Security shall remain valid until the contract is executed or until final disposition is made of the bids submitted. Such security will become the property of the Parish in the event the successful bidder fails or refuses to execute the contract or fails to produce performance and payment bonds upon contract signing. Bids shall remain binding for at least forty-five (45) days after the date set for the Bid Opening. In the event the Parish issues the Letter of Award during this period, the bid

accepted shall continue to remain binding until the execution of contract. Jefferson Parish and the lowest responsible bidder, by mutual written consent, may agree to extend the deadline for award by one or more extensions of thirty (30) calendar days.

When submitting online, bidders must submit an electronic bid bond through the respective online clearinghouse bond management system(s) as indicated in the electronic bid solicitation on Central Auction House. No scanned paper copies of any bid bond will be accepted as part of the electronic bid submission.

<u>Performance Bond</u>: A performance bond is required in 100% of the contract amount and is due at the signing of the formal contract, unless another percentage is required in the bid specifications. In the event of a conflict between these instructions and the bid specifications, the bid specifications shall control.

Payment Bond: A payment bond is required in 100% of the contract amount and is due at the signing of the formal contract, unless another percentage is required in the bid specifications. In the event of a conflict between these instructions and the bid specifications, the bid specifications shall control.

To the extent permitted by law, the bond requirements as set forth herein are waived insofar as Community Development Housing Rehabilitation Construction Contracts are concerned for single family, owner-occupied dwellings. The Parish Attorney's Office will omit the requirements in connection with Community Development Housing Rehabilitation Construction Contracts for single family, owner-occupied dwellings.

K. INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS

All bidders must submit with bid submission a current (valid) insurance certificate evidencing required coverages. Failure to comply will cause the bid to be rejected. The current insurance certificate will be used for proof of insurance at time of evaluation. Thereafter, and prior to contract execution, the low bidder will be required to provide final insurance certificates to the Parish which shall name the Jefferson Parish, its Districts, Departments and Agencies under the direction of the Parish President and the Parish Council as additional insureds regarding negligence by the contractor for the Commercial General Liability and the Comprehensive Automobile Liability policies. Additionally, said certificates should reflect the name of the Parish Department receiving goods and services and reference the respective Jefferson Parish bid number.

JEFFERSON PARISH REQUIRED STANDARD INSURANCE

WORKER'S COMPENSATION INSURANCE

As required by Louisiana State Statute, exception; Employer's Liability, Section B shall be \$1,000,000 per occurrence when Work is to be over water and involves maritime exposures to cover all employees not covered under the State Worker's Compensation Act, otherwise this limit shall be no less than \$500,000 per occurrence.

COMMERCIAL GENERAL LIABILITY

Shall provide limits not less than the following: \$1,000,000 Combined Single Limit per Occurrence for bodily injury and property damage.

COMPREHENSIVE AUTOMOBILE LIABILITY

Bodily injury liability \$1,000,000 each person; \$1,000,000 each occurrence. Property Damage Liability \$1,000,000 each occurrence.

UMBRELLA LIABILITY COVERAGE

An umbrella policy or excess may be used to meet minimum requirements.

FOR CONSTRUCTION AND RENOVATION PROJECTS:

The following are required if selected. Such insurance is due upon contract execution.

OWNER'S PROTECTIVE LIABILITY

To be for the same limits of liability for bodily injury and property damage liability established for commercial general liability.

BUILDER'S RISK INSURANCE

The contractor shall maintain Builder's Risk Insurance at his own expense to insure both the Parish of Jefferson and contractor as their interest may appear.

INSURANCE DEDUCTIBLES - The Parish Attorney with concurrence of the Director of Risk Management have waived the deductible section of the Terms and Conditions for all Invitations to Bid, until further notice.

L. INDEMNIFICATION

Bidder acknowledges that bidder recovered the cost of any required insurance in the contract price as required by LA R.S. 9:2780.1(I) and that bidder recovered any such cost for the purposes of insuring an obligation to indemnify Jefferson Parish, defend Jefferson Parish, or hold Jefferson Parish harmless and that bidder's indemnity liability is limited to the amount of the proceeds that are payable under the insurance policy or policies that bidder has obtained.

M. FAMILIARITY WITH LAWS AND ORDINANCES

Bidders shall familiarize themselves with and shall comply with all applicable Federal and State Laws, Parish/Municipal Ordinances, Resolutions, and the rules and regulations of all authorities having jurisdiction over construction of the project, which may directly or indirectly affect the work or its prosecution.

These laws and/or ordinances will be deemed to be included in the contract, the same as though herein written in full.

In case of conflict between the requirements of these specifications and any State and/or Federal Regulations or Laws, the State and/or Federal Regulations or Laws shall take precedence in all cases in which State and/or Federal Funding of the contract, in whole or in part, depends upon compliance with said State and/or Federal Regulations or Laws.

N. MISCELLANEOUS

The successful bidder may be required to furnish a statement of the origin, composition, and manufacture of materials to be used in construction of the work together with samples, which samples may be subjected to testing to determine their quality and fitness for the work, as specified.

Bidders are not to exclude from participation in, deny the benefits of, or subject to discrimination under any program or activity, any person in the United States on the grounds of race, color, national origin, sex or religion except that any exemption from such prohibition against discrimination on the basis of religion as provided in the Civil Rights Acts of 1964, or Title VI and VII of the Act of April 11, 1968 shall also apply, as amended; nor discriminate on the basis of age under the Age Discrimination Act of 1975, as amended; nor with respect to an otherwise qualified handicapped individual as provided in Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973, as amended. This assurance includes compliance with the administrative requirements of the Revenue Sharing final handicapped discrimination provisions contained in Section 51.55 (c), (d), (e), and (k) (5) of the Regulations.

Non-negotiable contract terms include but are not limited to taxes, assignment of contract, audit of records, EEOC and ADA compliance, record retention, content of contract/order of precedence, contract changes, force majeure, governing law, including ethics statements, claims or controversies, and termination based on contingency of appropriation of funds, as applicable.

ASPHALT STREET MAINTENANCE & SMALL JOBS

Two (2) year contract for asphalt street maintenance and small jobs (projects) to be provided on an as needed basis for the Jefferson Parish Department of Public Works – Streets and all Jefferson Parish agencies and municipalities, (Grand Isle addressed with specific items).

SURETY BID BOND:	A surety bond in the amount of 5% is due with the bid submission.
PAYMENT BOND:	A payment bond in the amount of 50% of the bid is due at the signing of the formal contract.
PERFORMANCE BOND:	A performance bond in the amount of 50% of the bid is due at the signing of the formal contract.

Louisiana Contract License Category: Highway, Street, and Bridge Construction

I. Definition of Terms:

Construction Zones: The immediate area of actual construction and all abutting areas which are used by the contractor and which interfere with the driving and walking public.

Job: For this proposal, the definition of "job" shall be the work described on any one issued work order.

Service Engineer: A person licensed as a professional engineer in accordance with the laws of the State of Louisiana, who is employed by the contractor to provide technical direction of the maintenance service.

The Owner: The owner is the Department of Public Works, Parish of Jefferson, State of Louisiana, acting through duly authorized governing authority, the Jefferson Parish Council.

Specifications: The directions, provisions and requirements contained herein setting our or relating to the method and manner of performing the work or to the quantities and qualities of material and labor to be furnished under this contract.

All work shall be performed in accordance with Jefferson Parish Standard Details for roadways, sidewalks and curbs, as well as applicable utilities. Copies are available at the Department of Engineering, Suite 802, Yenni Building, 1221 Elmwood Park Boulevard, Jefferson, Louisiana 70123.

II. General Specifications:

Bidder is required to bid on each item except for two items listed as "NO BID ITEM" (002 and 004).

The terms and conditions of Resolution No. 141125, as amended, will be considered a part of the bid whether attached or not. A copy may be obtained from the Office of the Parish Clerk, 6th Floor, General Government Building, 200 Derbigny Street, Gretna, Louisiana 70053.

The contractor shall be aware and shall be held responsible under this contract to the requirements prescribed by the following resolution.

Resolution No. 141125, as amended, "provides for a uniform set of general specifications and conditions for all contractors engaged in performing work or services for the Parish of Jefferson." This is an "asphalt maintenance and small job contract". It is intended to supplement work performed by regular maintenance forces of the Department of Public Works. Types of work under this contract include asphalt roadway maintenance projects such as asphaltic concrete overlay, extruded asphalt curb repairs, etc. roadway rehabilitations and reconstruction such as the addition of asphalt turning lanes, median crossings and additions to modifications to subsurface drainage systems and structures.

The quantities given in the proposal form are approximate for the comparison of bids only. The Parish reserves the right to purchase only such items and in such quantities as needed. Each "job" shall be estimated as to the tons of asphalt required to complete the amount of work proposed. Estimated time for completion shall be in accordance to size of "job".

Every effort will be made to consolidate the work so that work orders may be issued in combinations of the proposal items which cumulatively would amount to the equivalent of 100 tons of asphalt paving as a minimum.

All of the work within the limits of each job shall be shown to the contractor by a representative of the Department of Public Works prior to commencing work. Appropriate sketches and/or drawings may be furnished to the contractor with each work order. Work sites may be scattered for an individual work order; however, every effort will be made to consolidate the work to minimize scattered work sites. The contractor shall begin the work within 10 days after issuance of a work order.

Each work order will be issued in letter form with appropriate drawings or other attachments as necessary and will designate a work order number (WO#09/10-000). All correspondence, billing,

etc., pertaining to the work should reference this job number designation. Payment will be made upon receipt of detailed and itemized invoices and verification by public works inspectors regarding quantity and quality of work performed. Partial payments will be made only when completion is unduly delayed through no fault of the contractor, in which case requests for partial payment may be submitted monthly. Work orders outstanding at any given point in time during the contract year shall not exceed \$250,000.00.

If the contractor has a valid reason to hold off on a job, he has to obtain written permission from the Director of Streets for the stipulated delay. Also, the owner has the right to put a hold on a job at the beginning or when job is in progress without designating a reason. If the job is discontinued, the contractor will be compensated only for the items of work actually done and not for any down time.

If any sworn statement of claims are filed during the term of this contract, the parish shall withhold the next accruing payment and shall have the authority to satisfy the claim and deduct the amount from payments due.

Adequate safety precautions will be taken for all work performed under this contract. Necessary barricades, signs, lights and warning devices including the arrow board if requested by the engineering inspector will be installed and maintained by the contractor at no direct cost. The contractor shall be responsible for providing safe and expeditious movement of traffic through. The responsibility includes, but is not limited to such items as proper construction warning signing, signals, lighting devices, markings, barricades, channelization and hand signaling devices (flagging operations).

All traffic control devices shall be defined as all signs, signals, markings and other devices used to regulate, warn, or guide traffic, placed on, over or adjacent to a street, highway, pedestrian facility, or bikeway under the jurisdiction of Jefferson Parish.

All traffic control devices utilized under the terms of this contract shall be in accordance with the "Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices" (latest edition) as published by the American Traffic Safety Services Association (ATSSA).

All of the signing and traffic control devices shall be approved by the Office of Traffic Engineering, Jefferson Parish Department of Public Works prior to starting of the job. All expenses related to maintain traffic is incidental to the job, and no extra cost will be allowed for this. There is no added or additional payment for traffic control. All temporary striping shall be done by the contractor. There is no compensation for temporary striping.

During the performance of all work outlined in these specifications, the contractor will exercise due caution regarding underground utilities and will cooperate with representatives of the utility companies and/or parish departments to avoid damage to any installations. There is no additional compensation for layout of roadways, parking lots, turning lanes, walking tracks and any other facility.

Contractor must protect, support and maintain all subsurface, surface and aerial utilities. In the event of any damage to existing utilities, contractor shall restore service, as soon as possible at contractor's expense. Contractor shall have the sole responsibility of resolving any lawsuits and liabilities arising from defective workmanship and or improper maintenance of utilities. **The below specifications will apply to Items 0010 thru 0060, 0940 and 0950**:

Asphaltic Pavements

The hot mix asphalt shall conform to the latest ASTM and AASHTO specifications and all workmanship, equipment and materials shall be in accordance with the LADOTD, Office of Highways, Louisiana Standard Specifications for Roads and Bridges, (2006 edition) and applicable sections. (see tables below).

Bid prices for this item are to include all cost of labor, equipment and materials necessary to provide finished asphaltic concrete pavement in place as described in the above mentioned specification manuals.

All survey, initial and final layout of roadway re-construction is incidental to bid items. There is no separate compensation for this work. The accepted quantities of asphaltic concrete will be paid for at the contract unit price per ton (2,000 pound). The estimated quantities shown in the proposal are for hot mix asphalt found in Louisiana Standard Specifications for Roads and Bridges, 2006 edition and applicable sections. No other type of mix will be allowed without prior approval of the engineer (owner). Haul and/or loading tickets will be issued for each truck load of asphalt delivered by vendor's trucks and placed on the job. Tack coat or prime coat required will not be measured for separate payment, but will be considered incidental to the asphaltic concrete pay item.

The below specifications will apply to Items 0020 and 0040:

THIS IS A "NO BID" ITEM

Item 0020 will be to adjust the Binder Course and Item 0040 will be to adjust the Wearing Course. The adjustment will reflect the additional payment or a deduction in payment.

A. General: Payment for contract items indicated herein will be adjusted to compensate for cost differentials of Performance Grade (PG 64-22 and/or PG 70-22m) asphalt cement as

specified for the hot mix asphalt to be used, when such costs increase or decrease more than 5 percent from LDOTD's established base prices for these items. The base price indices for asphalt cements will be the monthly price indices in effect at the time the bids are opened for the project. The base price indices for asphalt cements will be as stated below in Paragraph (B) below.

Payment adjustments will be made for each pay estimate submitted when a price index during that period varies more than 5 percent from its respective base price index. The monthly price indices to be used with each pay estimate submitted will be the price indices for the month that corresponds to the month on the first asphalt ticket for the work order being billed, indicating when the asphalt was laid / delivered.

If the project is placed in default, payment adjustments will be based on the monthly price indices used for the last pay estimate submitted prior to the project being placed in default, unless a monthly index decreases in which case the lower monthly index will be used.

B. Performance Graded (PG) Asphalt Cements: The base price index will be the monthly price index in effect at the time of the bid opening as shown elsewhere herein. The monthly price indices will be the average, excluding the extreme outliers, of the unit prices for PG 64-22, and the average, excluding the extreme outliers, of the unit prices for PG 70-22m. The monthly prices for each of these asphalt materials will be F.O.B. (Free On Board) refinery or terminal as determined from the quoted prices effective on the first calendar day of each month from suppliers of these materials. Suppliers considered are those who have requested to participate in the liquid asphalt index determination and have supplied materials on DOTD projects within the past 12 months. These suppliers and materials shall be listed on the LDOTD'd Qualified Products List (QPL 41) and must be marketed in Louisiana.

Payment adjustments using line Items #0020 & #0040 will be made in accordance with the following formulas:

If Monthly Price Index exceeds Base Price Index, $P_A = (A - 1.05B) \times C \times D$

If Base Price Index exceeds Monthly Price Index, $P_A = (0.95B - A) \times C \times D$

Where:

- P_A = Price adjustment for Binder or Wearing course item
- A = Monthly Price Index for respective PG 64-22 or PG 70-22m in dollars per ton.
- B = Base Price Index for respective PG 64-22 or PG 70-22m in dollars per ton.
- C = Tons of asphaltic concrete
- D = Percent of respective asphalt cement, per job mix formula, in decimals

Jefferson Parish will verify the quantities of asphaltic concrete place per work order invoice with the respective asphalt cement content, excluding the asphaltic content in

reclaimed asphaltic pavement (RAP) as per the job mix formula. If the asphalt cement content changes during the course of invoicing for one issued work order, the respective weight (mass) of asphaltic concrete produced at each cement content will be reported.

The base price indices for asphalt cements will be posted on the LDOTD internet website before the 10th calendar of each month at the following URL: <u>www.dotd.louisiana.gov/lettings/lac price index/priceindices.asp</u>.

The bidder will submit his job mix formula (JMF) with each invoice to verify the percent of respective asphaltic cement (D in the formula above) used in the manufacture of the asphalt binder or wearing course used.

If the work performed for any issued work order project spans over 2 months, and a price adjustment must be made, then the price indices obtained from DOTD will be for the month that corresponds to the month on the first asphalt ticket for the work order being billed, indicating when the asphalt was laid / delivered for that work order.

*** Any price adjustment that is associated with Items 0940 and 0950 will be adjusted via line Items 0020 and 0040, respectively.

The below specifications will apply to Items 0070 thru 0100:

Pavement Removal and Disposal

Asphalt - 6" thick and less & Asphalt - greater than 6" thickness

These items cover work generally associated with breaking up, removal and disposal of existing asphaltic pavement in order to eliminate a badly deteriorated and/or failed section of roadway. Bid prices should include all costs for labor and equipment necessary to remove and dispose of existing asphalt for thicknesses as shown. Should the Parish desire, the contractor will dump the broken asphalt at a disposal site designated by the parish at no extra cost, provided that the disposal (dumping) site is within a 21-mile radius from the work site and may involve crossing the Mississippi River Bridge. Also should the Parish desire, the contractor will load the broken asphalt into parish trucks at the work site at no extra cost, provided that the parish trucks are present at the work site and do not unduly delay the contractor's work.

The accepted quantities of asphalt removed will be paid for at the contract unit price per square yard measured at the site.

Concrete - 6" thick and less & Concrete - greater than 6" thickness

These items cover work generally associated with breaking up, removal and disposal of existing Portland Cement Concrete pavements. Bid prices should include all costs for labor, equipment and materials necessary to remove and dispose of existing PCC pavement. Where concrete to be removed has been overlayed with asphalt, such asphaltic thickness to be paid for under Items 0090 and 0100. The accepted quantities of concrete removed shall be paid for at the contract unit price per square yard measured at the site. Disposal shall be the same as for asphalt.

The below specifications apply to Items 0110 thru 0160:

<u>Curbs</u>

The Asphaltic Mixture for curb construction shall be of Incidental Wearing Course mix conforming to LADOTD specifications, 2006 edition. Asphaltic curb shall be constructed by use of an approved self-propelled extruding machine. Prior to placing the curb, the contractor shall furnish and apply Asphaltic Tack Coat, Grade SS-1-H Emulsified Asphalt. Curb work shall perform to Parish Engineer's acceptance.

The Portland Cement Concrete mixture for curb construction shall be one which will provide proper workability, curb strength and minimum contraction cracking. PCC curbing may be placed by extruding machine or by forming and hand placement at contractor's option and will be bonded to holding surface in a manner approved by the Department of Streets, which may include dowelling and/or an approved bonding agent.

The accepted quantities of curbs will be paid at the contract unit price per linear foot, including all labor, equipment and materials incidental to the work.

No additional payment will be made for the removal of any type of existing curb.

The below specifications will apply to Items 0170 and 0180:

Excavation

This item covers work and materials generally associated with base, shoulder and dress-up functions. Excavation will be paid by cubic yard truck measure loaded at the job site or by computing theoretical volumes as the case may be.

Should the Parish desire, the contractor will dump excavated material at a disposal site designated by the parish at no added cost, provided that the disposal (dumping) site is within a 21-mile radius from the work site and may involve crossing the Mississippi River Bridge. Additionally, should the parish desire, the contractor will load excavated material onto parish trucks at the work site at the time of excavation and do not unduly delay the contractor's work. However, ultimate responsibility for disposal excavated material rests with the contractor.

The below specifications will apply to Items 0190 and 0200:

Fill Materials

Fill materials will be paid by cubic yard truck measure delivered to the work site and properly placed and graded, such as fill behind curbs or material for shoulders. Bid prices for fill materials should include placement and moderate compaction. High-density compaction and grading of materials when used for base construction to accommodate asphaltic concrete pavements, will be paid for separately under base preparation.

Haul and/or loading tickets will be issued for each truck load of material delivered and placed on the job and/or truck load of excavated material hauled from the work site.

The below specifications will apply to Item 0210:

Crushed Concrete - (Class I or Class II as required)

Recycled Portland Cement Concrete shall be used from approved stockpiles. Stockpiles of crushed concrete shall be uniform and free from solid reinforcing steel, debris, excessive amount of asphaltic materials and other foreign matter. Material sampling shall be in accordance with the requirements for stone by the LADOTD, latest edition and revisions and all applicable sections of the materials sampling manual.

Crushed concrete shall conform to the Abraison and Soundness Requirements of the Standard Specifications for Roads and Bridges and conform to the following gradation:

Aggregate passing the No. 40 sieve shall have a maximum liquid limit of 25 and a maximum plasticity index of 6.

Crushed concrete in Class II gradation shall have 100% passing through 4 inch mesh and a maximum of 20 percent passing through 2 inch mesh.

Class I and Class II crushed concrete shall be bid under item crushed concrete.

The below specifications will apply to Item 0220:

Limestone

Specifications for base course shall be in accordance with Louisiana Standard Specifications for Roads and Bridges, under "Stone". In addition, the material shall be calcitic or dolimitic with calcium carbonate not less than 85 percent and the silica content (impurities) not to exceed 5 percent. Limestone used on asphalt pavement shoulder shall be comparable to mexican limestone in color and gradation.

The material shall conform to the following gradation:

Aggregate shall conform to LADOTD Standard Specifications for Roads and Bridges, latest edition and revisions, Subsection 1003.01.

The below specifications will apply to Items 0370 and 0380:

Canal Out Fall Pipe

Corrugated metal pipe shall conform to AASHTO-M-246 and M-245 10 mil polymer, 10 mil - coated steel riveted 2 2/3" x 1/2" - connecting bands shall be 24" - corrugated band 2-piece with 4 1/2" galvanized steel rods and lugs with ramneck. The cost of the bands shall be included in the unit bid price for corrugated metal pipe.

The below specifications will apply to Items 0230 thru 0410:

Drain Pipe Installation

Bid prices should include all costs for labor, materials (pipe, excavation, bedding, boards, fill, etc.) and equipment necessary to install new drain pipe and/or remove and replace existing drain pipe as described under this item of the proposal.

All workmanship and materials shall be in accordance with the Jefferson Parish Department of Engineering Standard Plans. (Boards shall be used during the installation of concrete pipe.)

Each joint will be wrapped with filter cloth 36" wide and overlapped a minimum of 36".

The below specifications will apply to Items 0420 thru 0590:

Drainage Structures

Specific depths for drain structures will vary with each project. However, it is anticipated that most subsurface drainage systems installed under this contract will be generally shallow. For bidding purposes it shall be assumed 5' more or less in depth.

Frames, grates and covers for manholes, catch basins and drop inlets shall be of the heavy duty type and be of domestic United States manufacturer.

Typical details for construction of drainage structures are available from the Engineering Division of the Department of Public Works upon request.

<u>The below specifications will apply to Items 0560 thru 0566 – Ring Adjustments on Existing</u> <u>Manhole:</u>

These items will be used to pay for new rings when adjustments are needed based on the different thickness ranges. All rings will be metal rings. Plastic rings will be used only when approved by Streets Dept. inspector on site.

Note: If rings are removed during the milling operation, and reused (regardless of material type), then there will be no pay to reinstall these rings. Also, if rings are removed during the milling operation, not properly secured, and then stolen, the Parish will not pay for replacement rings.

<u>The below specifications will apply to Item 0575 – Water Valve (Floating) Manhole</u> <u>Adjustment:</u>

This item will be used to address smaller diameter water valves in asphalt roadways that are being converted to a manhole frame & cover. See attached detail drawing for particulars regarding installation.

The below specifications will apply to Item 0600 - Base Preparation - New Construction:

This item covers work generally associated with setting up new base material (roadways, parking areas, etc.). As a suitable base upon which to place asphaltic concrete/concrete pavement. Bid price shall include all costs for labor and equipment necessary to scarify, grade, shape, compact and otherwise condition new materials as a suitable base. Any materials required shall be included in bid price under the item.

The below specifications will apply to Item 0610 - Base Preparation - Existing Base:

Scarifying and grading existing base for even surface. Any added base material to cover deficiency shall be paid under the bid item.

<u>The below specifications will apply to Item 0620 - Saw Cut Pavement – Asphalt or PCC</u> <u>Concrete (per inch depth):</u>

Bid prices for this item shall include all costs for labor, material and equipment necessary to machine cut asphaltic or Portland Cement Concrete pavement. Payment will be by linear foot of cut per inch of depth.

The below specifications will apply to Item 0630 - Crack and Joint Sealing - Liquid Poured Asphalt Type Sealant, applied, per gallon:

Bid prices shall include all costs for labor, materials and equipment required to apply an approved asphalt filler to cracks and for joints in asphaltic concrete pavements. Opening shall be cleaned as necessary in accordance with generally accepted procedures prior to pouring the sealant.

The below specifications will apply to Item 0640 - Sand Mix Asphalt Joint Sealer:

A mixture of concrete sand, pumped sand and liquid asphalt in the ratio of 70/22/8 (approximate proportion) to fill the open joints in asphaltic pavements.

Bid unit prices quoted include all costs for labor, materials and equipment. Openings shall be cleaned as necessary in accordance with general procedure prior to filling these cracks with the sealer.

<u>The below specifications will apply to Item 0650 - Concrete Curb and Gutter - Rollover or</u> <u>Barrier, 200 square inch cross section max:</u>

Bid prices for this item shall include all costs for labor, material and equipment necessary to install conventional Portland Cement Concrete curb and gutter (barrier or rollover) with a maximum cross section area of 200 square inches. This pay item will also include cost for excavation 8

inches thick and bedding material required for installation. Payment shall be per linear foot of curb installed.

Parish Inspector / Engineer will determine which type concrete to use and inform the contractor:

- 4000 PSI 24 hours high early strength with superplasticizer and other additives if applicable.
- 4000 PSI 72 hours high early strength with superplasticizer and other additives if applicable.

The below specifications will apply to Item 0660 - Concrete Curb and Gutter - Rollover or Barrier, 300 square inch cross section max:

Bid prices for this item shall include all costs for labor, material and equipment necessary to install conventional Portland Cement Concrete curb and gutter (barrier or rollover) with a maximum cross section area of 300 square inches. This pay item will also include cost for excavation 8 inches thick and bedding material required for installation. Payment shall be per linear foot of curb installed.

Parish Inspector / Engineer will determine which type concrete to use and inform the contractor:

- 4000 PSI 24 hours high early strength with superplasticizer and other additives if applicable.
- 4000 PSI 72 hours high early strength with superplasticizer and other additives if applicable.

The below specifications will apply to Item 0670 - Concrete Curb and Gutter - Rollover or Barrier, 400 square inch cross section max:

Bid prices for this item shall include all costs for labor, material and equipment necessary to install conventional Portland Cement Concrete curb and gutter (barrier or rollover) with a maximum cross section area of 400 square inches. Following information must be included in the submittal to be considered for approval:

- 1. Documentation (with contact names and phone numbers) that the grid has been utilized on projects totaling a minimum of 3,000,000 square yards worldwide.
- 2. Manufacturers signed certification by an authorized representative of the quality control department that the grid components meet all of the requirements of this specification.
- 3. A full size roll of the grid (for laboratory analysis).
- 4. Packaging requirements. The mesh shall be packaged in standard-width rolls of specified lengths. Each roll of mesh shall be packaged individually in a suitable wrapper to help protect the mesh from damage due to ultra-violet light and moisture during normal storage and handling.
- 5. Storage requirements. The material must be stored in dry, covered conditions free from dust and should be stocked vertically to avoid misshaped rolls.

- 6. Identification requirements. Each roll shall be labeled or tagged in such a manner that the information for product identification and other quality control purposes can be read from the label without opening the roll packaging. Each roll shall be identified by the manufacturer in a manner that the following can be retrieved for quality/auditing purposes: job number, loom number, production date and shift, tare weight of packaging material, width and length of fabric on the roll and net weight of the mesh.
- 7. Safety precautions. Gloves are recommended to prevent contact with the material.
- 3. Construction methods:

The area on which the mesh is to be placed shall be clean of dirt, dust or other deleterious material by sweeping or other approved methods. All base failures must be repaired prior to laying the mesh.

The surface temperature before laying the mesh shall be between 40 degrees F (5 degrees C) and 14 degree F (60 degrees C). The mesh shall not be placed when the general weather conditions, in the opinion of the engineer, are not suitable.

Tack coat, shall not be sprayed below, or onto, the mesh without prior approval. If tack coat is required for extra adhesion, it must be applied a minimum of 24 hours in advance of mesh placement to ensure complete curing of the tack coat material. This tack coat will not be paid for, but will be considered subsidiary to this item.

Mesh shall be laid out by mechanical means under sufficient tension to eliminate ripples. Should ripples occur, these must be removed by pulling the mesh tight or in extreme cases, for example, in tight radius, by cutting and laying flat. A sharp knife may be used for cutting.

Transverse joints must be lapped in the direction of the pavers by 75 millimeters (3 inches) minimum. Longitudinal joints must be lapped by 25 millimeters (1 inch) minimum. The surface of the mesh shall be rolled with a rubber coated drum roller or pneumatic tire roller; one or two passes being sufficient to activate the adhesive. Tires must be cleaned regularly with asphalt cleaning agent.

After the rolling is completed, construction and emergency traffic may run on the mesh with regulated speed control. Whenever mixtures contain less than 20 percent reclaimed materials, Grade AC-30 asphalt cement shall be used. Grade AS-10 asphalt cement shall be used in all mixtures containing from 20 to 30 percent reclaimed materials. Regardless of the quantity of reclaimed asphaltic concrete used, the mixture produced shall conform to all control and acceptance requirements for the type mixture specified. The quantity of recycled bituminous plant mix pavement shall be paid at the contract bid price per ton under asphalt binder.

Work Stoppage Due to Publically Declared Emergency

If there is an emergency declared by the federal, state or local government in Jefferson Parish or in any portion thereof, then all work on this project shall cease until such time as the contractor is instructed to resume work by department director (no one else) who has jurisdiction over the project.

If there is any type of work which must proceed to prevent harm to persons or property, or damage to the project itself; then contractor should immediately contact the department director for necessary instructions. If contractor is unable to contact the department director, contractor may perform the work necessary to prevent such harm in accordance with industry safety standards.

Contractor shall be entitled to an extension of time for the period of the stoppage, but shall not be entitled to any additional compensation by reason thereof.
