Attachment B: Specifications

Specifications: The specifications describe the <u>minimum requirements</u>. The equipment shall be new, of current manufacture, a production model, and must meet all State and Federal safety standards in effect at the time of delivery.

Bidder should indicate either their compliance with each stated specification requirement, or their proposed specification. Failure to indicate any deviations will be interpreted to mean bidder is furnishing exactly as specified.

Any additions, deletions, or variations from the specifications should be noted in writing. Minor deviations from the specifications which do not impair comparative functional equivalency will be accepted.

A complete set of manufacturer's literature and specifications should be submitted with your bid.

Successful vendor shall furnish owners, operations, and service manuals at time of delivery.

Pre-Delivery Servicing and Adjustment: Do not attach any dealer identification, advertising, or similar material to the vehicle(s). The vehicle(s) shall be clean and free from defects when delivered. Prior to acceptance by the State, each vehicle shall be serviced and adjusted for operational use, to include as a minimum the following:

- 1. Focusing of lights
- 2. Tuning of engine
- 3. Adjustment of accessories
- 4. Checking of electrical, braking and suspension systems.
- 5. Charging of battery(ies)
- 6. Alignment of front end
- 7. Inflation of tires
- 8. Balancing of all wheels, including the spare.
- 9. Complete lubrication of engine, chassis, and operating mechanisms, with recommended grades of lubricants for the ambient temperature at the point of delivery. Appropriate additives.

Standard Equipment: All all-terrain vehicles (ATV) offered under the contract shall be equipped with all factory equipment advertised as "Standard Equipment". Deletions from "Standard Equipment" will not be accepted, unless otherwise specified.

Design: All all-terrain vehicles shall be new models that are in current production. All ATVs shall be complete with all necessary operating components and accessories customarily furnished, together with such modifications as may be necessary to enable the vehicles to function reliably and efficiently in sustained operation. The ATVs shall be designed to permit ready accessibility for maintenance purposes with minimal disturbance of other components or assemblies.

Attachment B: Specifications

Components, Assemblies And Accessories: Components, assemblies and accessories to be delivered to the State shall meet or exceed all requirements of this and the applicable detailed specifications.

Emission Controls: All engines furnished under these specifications shall comply with the regulations of the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) in effect on the date of manufacture.

Cooling System: Unless otherwise specified, cooling systems shall be manufacturer's standard equipment for the models specified as equipped. Cooling system design and capacity shall maintain the engine at optimum safe temperature under all operating conditions without any loss of coolant or overheating of engine and components.

Suspension System: Suspension system shall be adequate strength to sustain loads.

Controls And Operating Mechanisms: Controls and operating mechanisms shall be located for ready access by the operator and shall be clearly identified as to function.

Exterior Finish: All-terrain vehicles shall be painted with standard factory color unless otherwise specified.

Materials: Materials used shall be new and quality conforming to current engineering and manufacturing practices. Materials shall be free of defects and shall be suitable for the intended service.

Optional Equipment: The Office of State Procurement reserves the right to add or delete any optional equipment listed in the factory price lists at Dealer's invoice cost. A completely priced factory option sheet showing Dealer's invoice cost should be furnished with the bid. Option sheets must also show Dealer invoice cost on the basic models bid. A listing of all standard equipment for each all-terrain vehicle bid should be included with the bid. All available factory option price lists must be provided prior to award. Price list must be of latest prices available prior to bid opening date. Altered price list will not be accepted.

Service And Repair: The State of Louisiana shall expect the manufacturer to have adequate stocks of replacement parts available to service the equipment in this solicitation and to make delivery within a reasonable time of all replacement parts to their dealers who may be required to perform the service. The State further expects that warranty service and repairs as well as nonwarranty service and repairs will be handled without prejudice by local dealerships throughout Louisiana.

Warranty: All purchases through the contract will include the factory standard warranty.

Dealer will be responsible for all transportation charges incurred when replacing any defective parts under the applicable warranty.

Attachment B: Specifications

Responsibility For Inspection: Unless otherwise specified in the contract or purchase order, the supplier shall be responsible for all inspection and test requirements necessary to ensure compliance with requirements of this and the applicable detailed specifications. This action does not preclude subsequent inspection and testing by the State of Louisiana to further determine conformance with specification requirements of quality standards of workmanship, material and construction techniques.

Delivery: All all-terrain vehicles shall be delivered fully serviced and ready for use and will be accepted in accordance with the individual purchase order. The Dealer shall be required to make any necessary adjustments or install omitted equipment prior to acceptance of the vehicle. No facilities or personnel will be provided by the State to handle any make-ready adjustments or equipment installations.

Delivery performance is subject to monitoring. Unsatisfactory performance shall be grounds for contract termination.

IMPORTANT NOTE: All vehicles must have a full tank of fuel at time of delivery.

Service Manuals: Service manuals covering all components of the all-terrain vehicle will be delivered with the vehicle.

Workmanship: Any equipment delivered under this specification is subject to rejection if there is evidence of poor workmanship by either the vendor, or the original manufacturer. Any defect must be corrected to specification and to the satisfaction of the agency prior to invoice payment.
